## The Gospel of George Bush

Fourth Sunday in Lent John 3: 14-21 March 10, 1991

An interesting historical note.
The Truce of God was an attempt by the Medieval Church to bring Medieval society closer to Christian standards. Under the Truce, which started in France early in the eleventh century, and then spread to Germany and Italy, the fighting of wars was forbidden during the seasons of Advent and Lent, as well as between Saturday night and Monday morning throughout the rest of the year.

The Truce of God was never fully enforced, but it did exercise some restraint upon men in chaotic times.

Speaking of Fay Weldon, I bought her novel, The Heart of the Country, a week ago at the delete book counter in Zeller's.

Her novel did for me what the Truce of God attempted to do for Medleval society. It was better than taking a forty-day Ignatian retreat or participating in weeks of Lenten reflections.

Her novel is an immersion.

It's a moral tale of decay in the modern world. A movie promo might read: A woman with everything, loses everthing, and discovers happiness and reality.

Interestingly enough, the narrator is a mad woman, who at the end of the novel, like Don Quixote at the end of his life, becomes sane.

Spiritual reading doesn't get any better than this:

Natalie was lucky. It's not everyone's good fortune to have things occur in their lives, just like that, out of the blue. No, usually if you want things to change you have to make them change, and most of us don't want the responsibility. So we do nothing and drift on in unsatisfactory situations waiting for magic, which doesn't happen.
