Police seek suspects in vandalism cases

Halton Regional Police suspect one or two groups may be responsible for four break and enters in Georgetown resulting in costly damage but no stolen property. -

The first occurrence took place at Stewarttown Public School early Friday evening where unknown culprits smashed a window to gain entry to the school. Once inside, chairs were thrown into two showcase windows and a fire extinguisher was discharged in the halls. Police estimate the damage at \$2,000.

Similar destruction took place overnight Friday at Glen Williams Public School Friday when three wire mesh screens, a window pane and window were vandalized causing approximately \$500 damage.

The destruction continued Saturday when a business on Glen Road in Georgetown was illegally entered and a clock, flourescent light bulb and window were smashed, causing \$200 damage. The vandals also threw screws, bolts and pennies all over the floor and discharged two fire extinguishers into the room.

Police were able to get a brief description of two males who may ahve been responsible for the vandalism spree.

One of the suspects is described as white, 18-19 years old, male, approximately 5'11", weighing approximately 150 pounds with brown hair. He was wearing a dark baseball cap, dark grey of blue ski jacket, blue jeans and white running shoes.
