Pike fishing derby

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority with the cooperation from the Orangeville Chamber of Commerce is hosting the first annual Pike Fishing Derby in the Orangeville Reservoir on May 18-19.

The purpose of the derby is to promote the fishery of the reservoir while at the same time encouraging the anglers to turn fish in live so they can be transported to other areas to develop other urban angling opportunities and also to reduce the competition

between the Pike and the Largemouth Bass of the reservoir. The hope is that the Bass will eventually become more abundant, reducing the threat the Pike are posing to the Trout populations down river.

The reservoir, while not open to gasoline powered boats, offers ample fishing opportunities from shore, electric powered crafts, row boats or canoes. It is hoped that this pilot project will be a success and become an annual event.
