GDHS student to visit U.N.

Georgetown District High School student Richard Cook will get a chance to see if 'New York, New York' is worth loving when he travels there this summer.

Richard, 16, a grade 11 student at GDHS, will visit New York and the United Nations from July 16-26 on a trip sponsored by the Verdun Rebekah Lodge no. 184 of Georgetown.

It's the first time in 20 years the Lodge has sponsored a student for the trip. Jean King, Secretary for the Lodge, approached Georgetown District High School teacher Jim Broughton, of the Social Science Department, with the idea earlier this year.

Mr. Broughton made up a quiz on the United Nations for interested students, in which

Richard earned top marks.

Adam Poyntz placed second highest on the test and will go to New York if Richard gets sick or cannot make the trip.

Mrs. King is the co-ordinator for Ontario for 29 other Provincial Lodges which are sponsoring students in their areas.

Richard said he's very excited

about going to New York since he's never been there before. "I want to see how the UN works," he said. He already knows some of the UN's history from the school quiz.

When he returns, he'll give a summary of his trip to the Rebekah's at one of their Lodge meetings.
