

Hydro Commission fed up with being nice

However, when the commission heard Friday from its General Manager Gerry Trudell that the utility was owed close to \$600,000 in late payment fees for this month alone, it decided action must be taken.

The utility usually has between \$120,000 and \$150,000 in late payment bills per month, said Mr. Trudell.

Hydro Commissioner and Halton Hills Mayor Russ Miller said during the meeting he has no problem cutting power to those refusing to pay their hydro bill because the weather is relatively warm. He would be concerned if the month was January or February.

Mr. Trudell said effective immediately those customers who are two or three months late in

paying their hydro bill will be the first to receive notification that their power will be turned off unless they pay their bill promptly.

Between 300 and 400 people and businesses hold outstanding hydro bills with the number spread throughout Georgetown and Acton, said Mr. Trudell.

Mr. Trudell said if the Commission doesn't press people to pay

their bills the utility could incur a 1991 loss of \$30,000 in unpaid hydro bills. The figure for 1990 was just below \$11,000, said Mr. Trudell.

Meanwhile, the Commission directed Mr. Trudell to investigate other ways to recover

outstanding bills.

One problem facing hydro centres around homeowners not paying their bills and then moving outside of Halton Hills.

In this situation, it's practically impossible to recover utility-owed money, said Mr. Trudell.

ly what the movies contained but a Toronto Star reporter quoted a Metro Sergeant as saying the movies contained scenes of bestiality, degradation, sex and violence and scenes that were dehumanizing.

When asked if the charges were to be used as a trial case by police, Sergeant Smith said that will likely be used as a defence by the store owner but the police felt they were just enforcing the law.

"We're responsible for enforcing the pornographic provision of the criminal code," said Sergeant Smith. "We don't check and see if the movies have been passed by the Film Review Board."

The board screens and classifies all commercial films and videos in Ontario and approved the videos that were seized from the Adult Only Video stores.

"In spite of the board, we enforce the criminal code," said Sergeant Smith.
