

Companies learn of program

Local companies had a chance Wednesday to learn from the experience Solinst Canada Ltd. in Glen Williams has gained through participation in the province's Technical Personal Program during a luncheon at the North Halton Golf and Country Club in Georgetown.

Solinst President Doug Belshaw addressed the luncheon speaking on how the province's funding program for small businesses permitted the company to expand.

TTP, which is administered by the Ministry of Trade and Technology, provides funding to those companies wanting to hire scientific or technical personnel where companies may not otherwise have been able to hire, according to a Ministry press release.

The program allowed Solinst to hire an employee who had expertise in an area the company had determined it was deficient in, said Mr. Belshaw in an interview before the luncheon. Mr. Belshaw wouldn't expand any more on the new position.

Solinst manufactures ground water monitoring and geotechnical equipment, said Mr. Belshaw.

If a company is permitted to hire a person through the program, the province will provide 50 per cent of the person's salary, during the first year and 25 per cent of the person's salary over the second year to a maximum of \$45,000, said provincial TPP coordinator Bill Lampert.

Mr. Lampert went on to say, since the program was introduced in September 1989 "well over 300 companies have come on board." The program has been allocated \$38 million of which \$9 million has already been distributed, he said.

"The program has far exceeded our expectations," said Mr. Lampert.

Mr. Belshaw said the program is a good one but companies can't qualify for it as easily as it may appear.

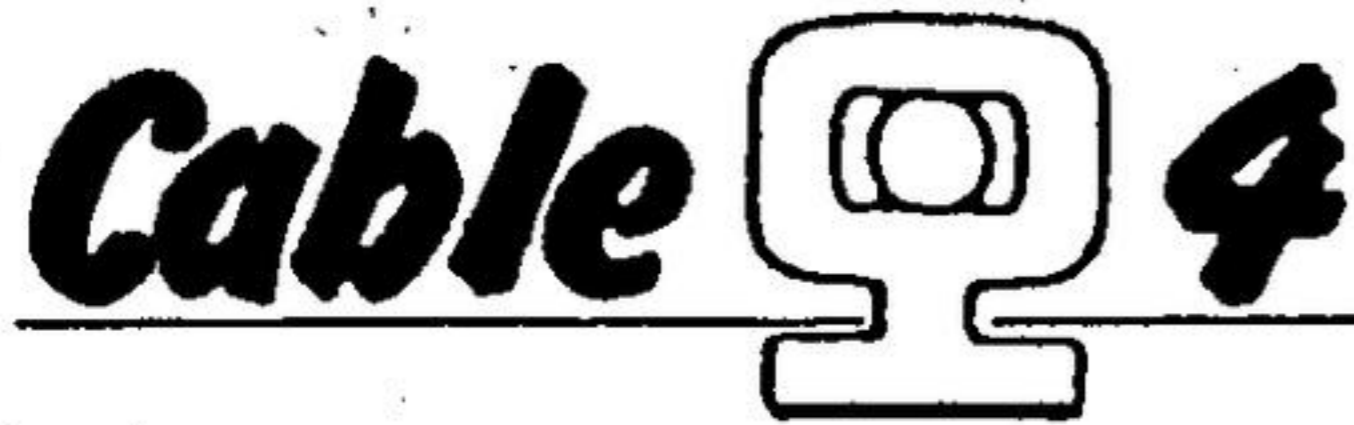
Plans were made for the District Annual meeting, which will be held at the Cheltenham United Church and hosted by the Terra Cotta W.I. on May 13.

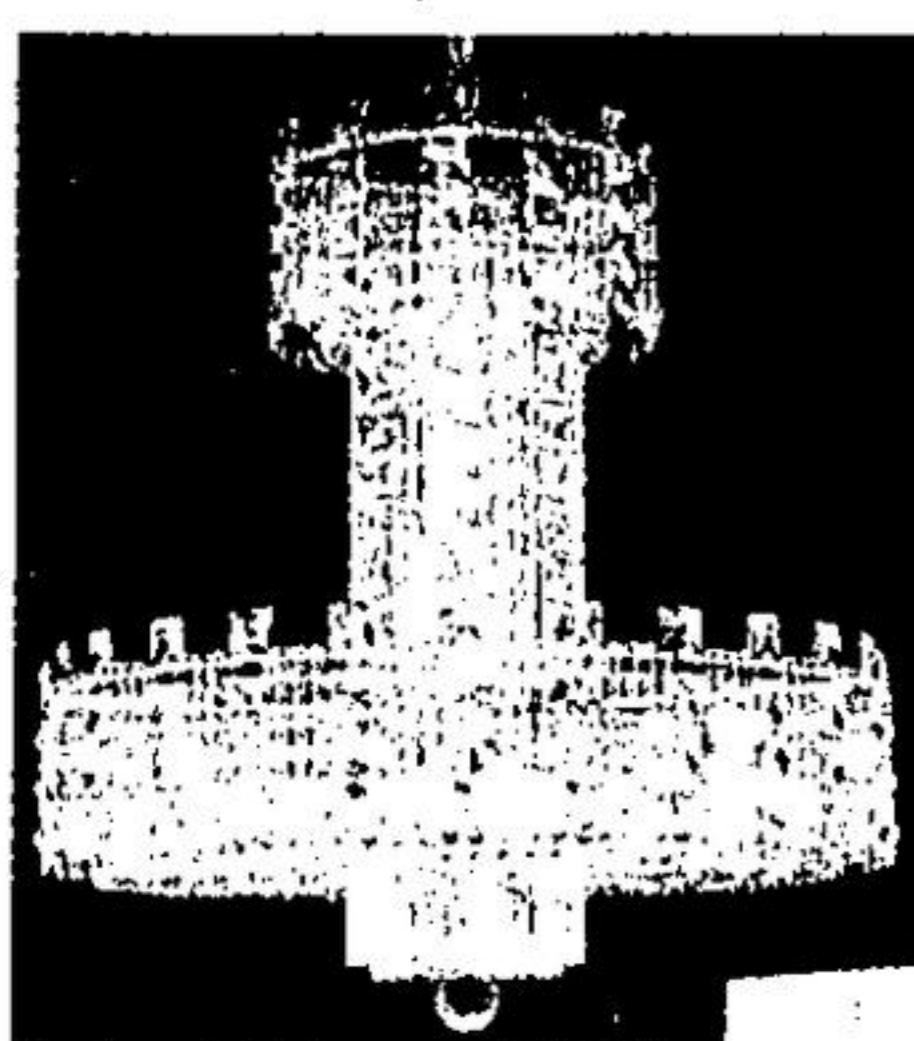
