In addition to the development of athletic and creative abilities, participants are provided with the opportunity to strengthen their social skills and build self-confidence through peer interaction. Safety, fair play and cooperation are elements which are further stressed by the trained program staff.

Individuals having mental or physical disabilities are also encouraged to participate. A Special Needs Facilitator is available to ensure that the

disabled are matched with a program that best meets their needs and interests. Please contact the Recreation and Parks Office by June 7 so that such arrangements can be made.

Last summer's Recreation and Parks program received good reviews from parents and participants. Our programs had approximately 1400 registered participants - a clear sign of success. Many of last year's camps reported capacity attendance and this summer's Georgetown

Children's Theatre Camp is already sold out. Registration for all programs is ongoing throughout the summer up until the Friday before a particular camp is scheduled to commence. However, to avoid disappointment it is suggested that you register as early as possible.
