

Agricultural Hall of Fame to officially open

Minister of Agriculture and Food, Elmer Buchanan, will officially open the Ontario Agricultural Hall of Fame Gallery in its new home, the W. A. Stewart Hall, Sunday, June 2, 1991, at the Ontario Agricultural Museum.

The 12th annual unveiling ceremony will honor Elliot Irwin McLoughry, Osborne L. Sager and Harold W. M. Smith who will join 85 previously inducted men and women in the W. A. Stewart Hall of Fame Gallery.

The general public is welcome to attend the official opening ceremony at 2:30 p.m. and the unveiling ceremony at 3:00 p.m., June 2, 1991. Tickets can be purchased by contacting the Ontario Agricultural Museum.

The Hall of Fame Gallery is open for public viewing for anyone visiting the museum. Located five km west of Milton, take Highway No. 401, exit 320 or 312 north. The museum is open for the 1991 season May 21st until

September 22nd, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily.

HONOREES

Elliot Irwin McLoughry
(Waterloo County, Ontario)
1894 - 1987

Devoted to improving agricultural production, the mark of Elliot McLoughry can be seen in every facet of the industry. His expertise was in translating the scientific advancements of the classroom and laboratory to practical applications on the farm.

Osborne Sager
(St. George, Ontario)
1898 - 1973

Osborne Sager was a teacher by example. After graduating from O.A.C. he went on to develop his expertise in dairy cattle, particularly in Holstein Friesians. His desire to promote excellence in agriculture is best recorded by his involvement with the Ontario Association of

Harold Smith
(Vineland Station, Ontario)
1916 - 1989

Ontario's tender fruit industry owes much to the contributions of Harold Smith. He played leadership roles in the commercial production of red haven peaches and in the implementation of Ontario's off-shore labor program. Nominated by Brian Culp, Jordan, Ontario.

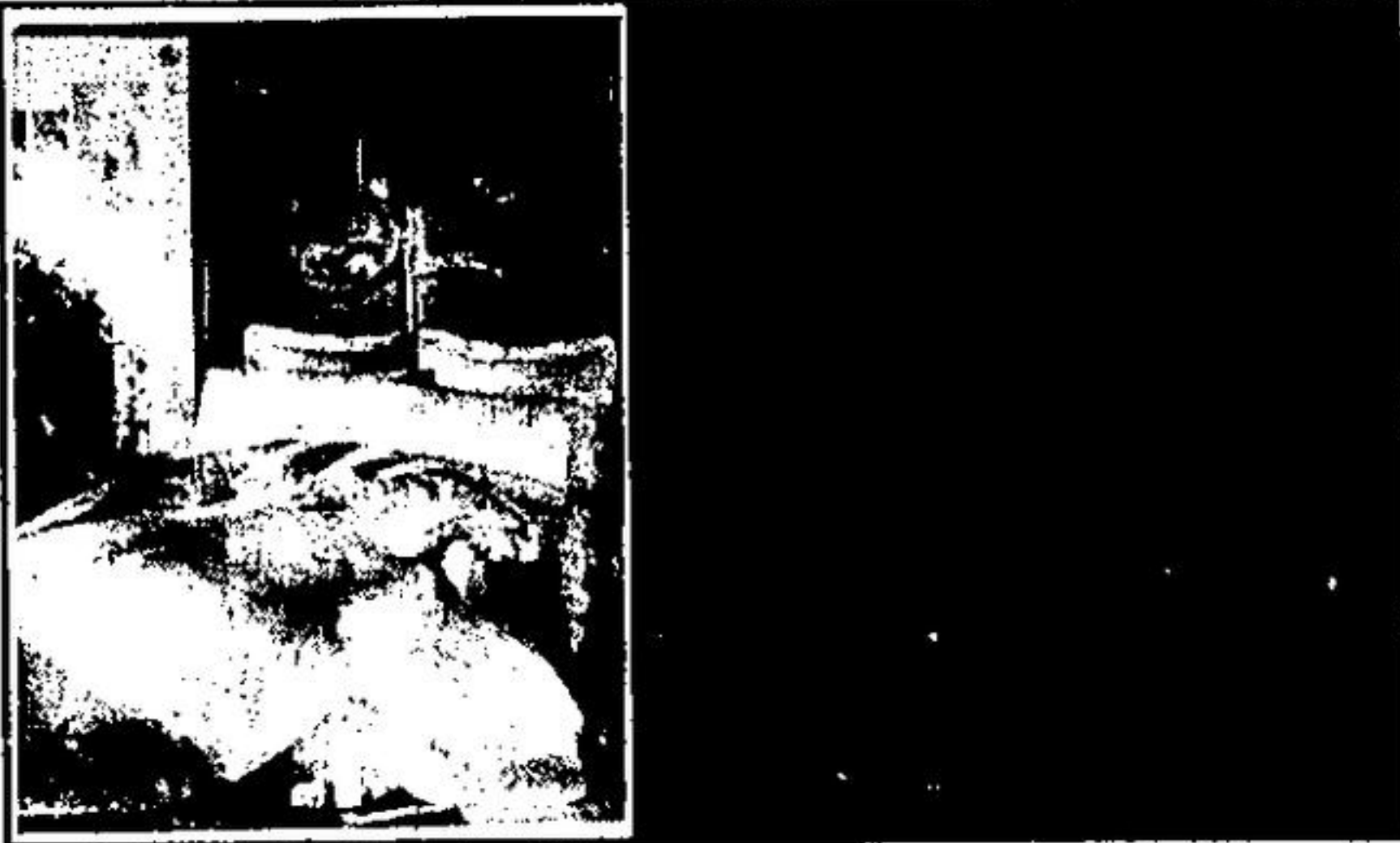
