High School students to experience history

High school students will have the opportunity to experience hands-on history and earn a senior history credit at an archaeological excavation of a prehistoric Indian village.

The dig begins on July 28 and ends Aug. 17, with a break during the weekend of Aug. 10-11. The site is near Woodbridge, just north of Metro Toronto.

The field school includes an introduction to archaeological theory, excavation field work,

background on native Indian cultures, laboratory analysis of artifacts, and a hands-on introduction of subsistence skills and culture. The excavation is on the site of a village which existed before native contact with Europeans.

The school is sponsored by the North York Board of Education, in co-operation with the City of Vaughan, the Royal Ontario Museum, and The Metropolitan Toronto and Region Conservation Authority. Students live in

residence in the Authority's Boyd Conservation Field Centre, a residential educational facility located near Woodbridge.
