Canadian babies go through 4.3 million disposable diapers a day. Still, that only accounts for two per cent of the volume of garbage in landfills.

Since 1910 the number of incorporated cities in Canada has nearly tripled. Technically Calgary is Canada's largest city, with a population of 693,000. The City of Toronto is in second place with 612,000. Canada's smallest city is Greenwood, B.C. with a population of 767 people.

In Canada we go through an estimated 175 million spray cans each year. The good news is that 99 per cent of those cans are CFC free, which are propellants that harm the ozone layer. The bad news is that the butane based propellants replacing CFCs may contribute to urban smog.
