Four members of the G.F.S.C. event, plus two more were there because one is treasurer of the C.O.S. and one is an area representative, so Georgetown was well represented.

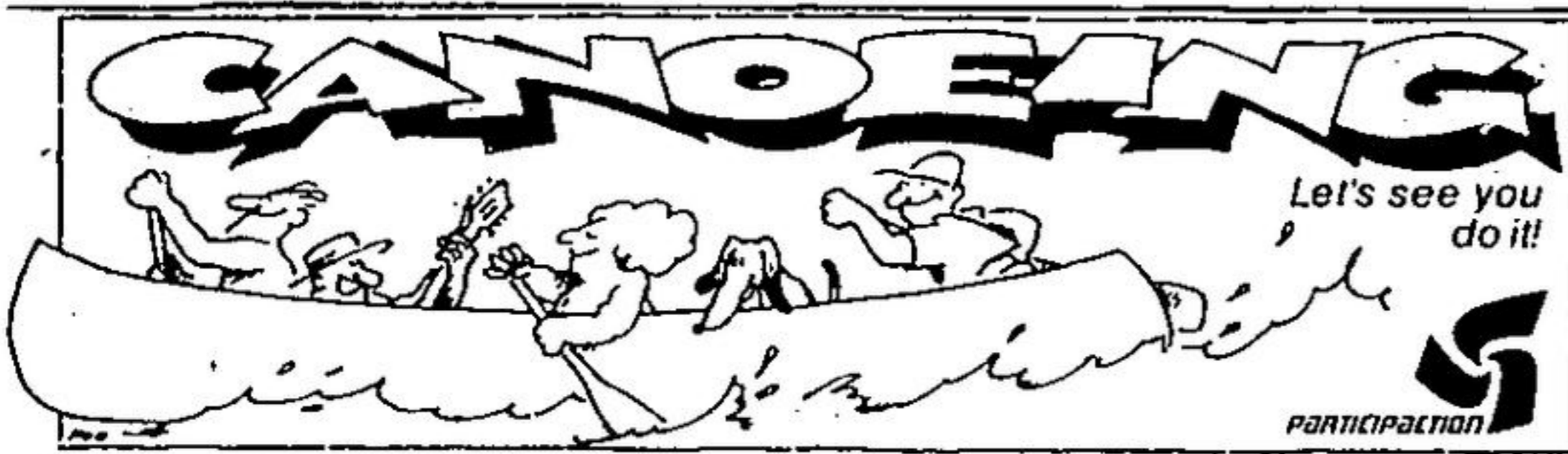

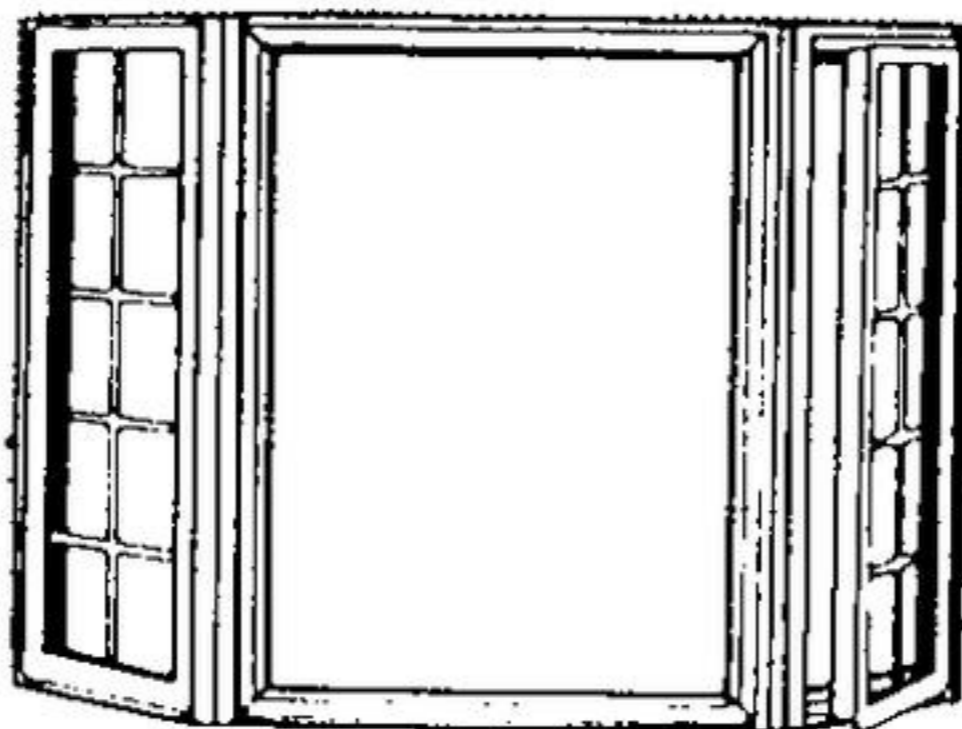
