- 1) Proposed reconstruction of Dublin Line (First Line), Dufferin Aggregates entrance northerly 700 metres
- 2) Proposed resurfacing of Dublin Line (First Line), Regional Road 9 to Dufferin Aggregate entrance
- 3) Proposed asphalt surfacing and knoll lowering on 27 Side Road, Blue Mountain Place to the intersection of Eighth Line and 27 Side Road

The Town of Halton Hills invites you to attend a Public Information Centre to review the above-mentioned Design Proposals.

- 1) The Reconstruction of Dublin Line (First Line) in the Town of Halton Hills. The project extends from Dufferin Aggregates entrance northerly to the proposed entrance to the Greystone Golf and Country Club.
 - 2) The Resurfacing of Dublin Line (First Line) in the Town of Halton Hills. This project extends from Regional Road 9 to Dufferin Aggregate entrance.
 - 3) The Asphalt Surfacing of 27 Side Road in the Town of Halton Hills. This project extends from Blue Mountain Place to the intersection of Eighth Line and 27 Side Road. Included in this project is the lowering of a knoll to provide improved stopping sight distance.
