## Respect won from soccer loss

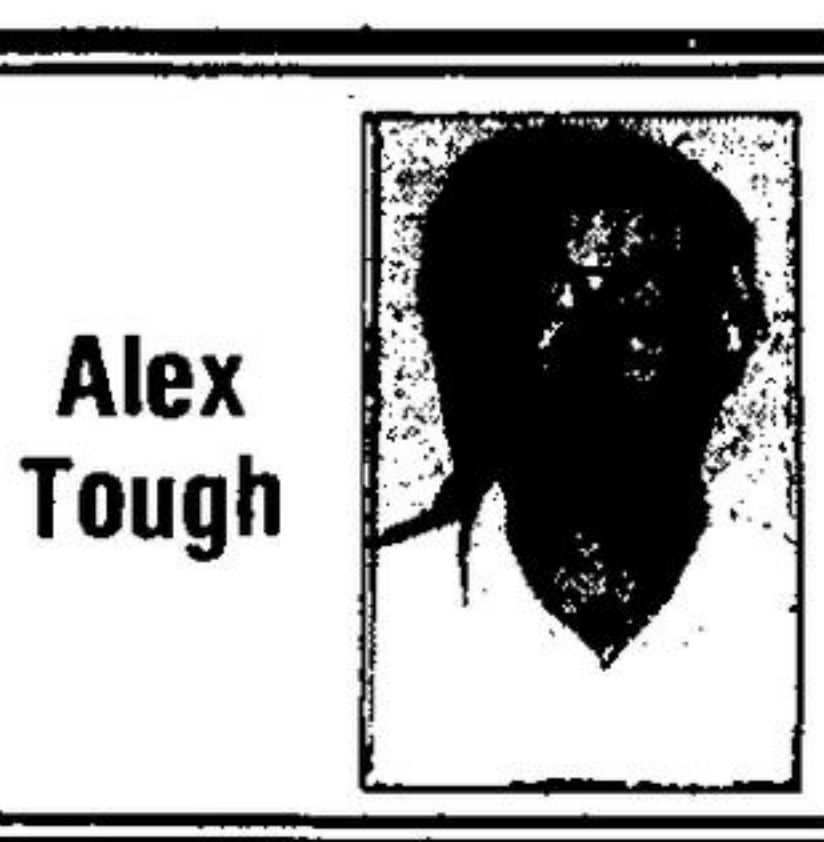

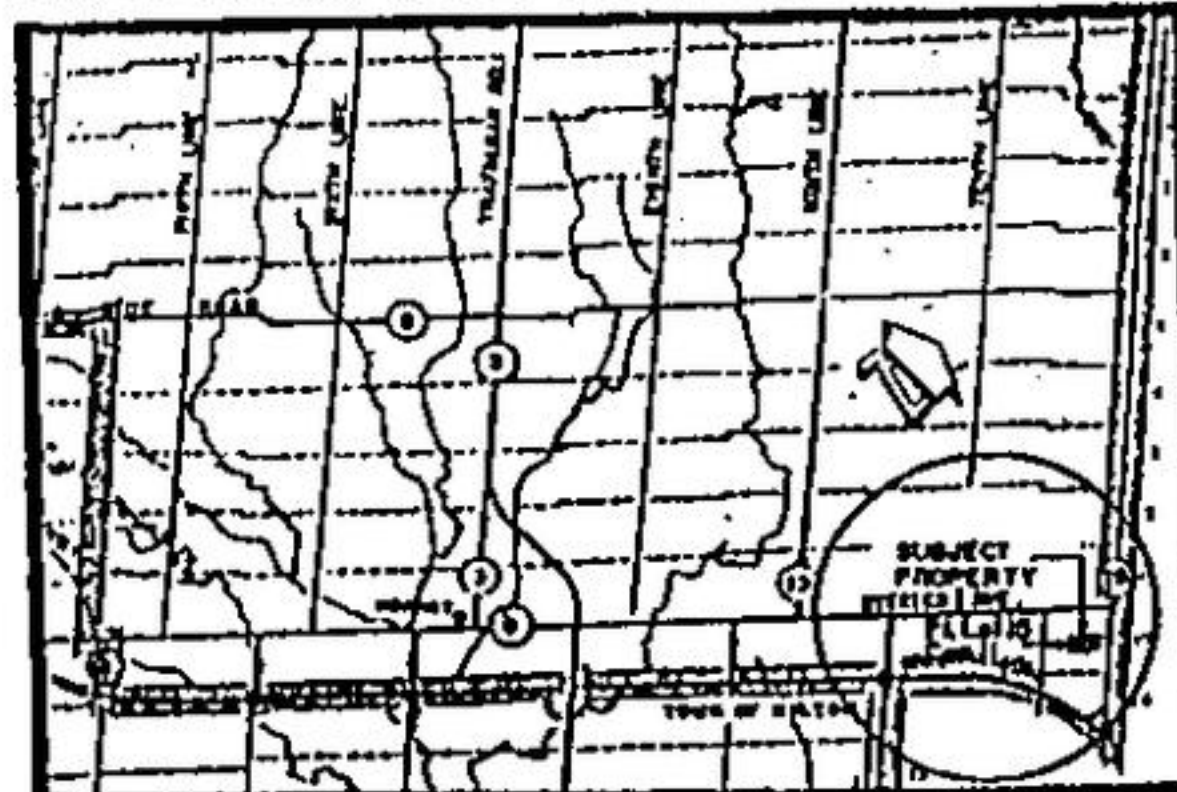
The senior league's co-ordinator has juggled around some home field times to assist the youth rep squads in some much needed practice time on the fields, without too many upsets to schedules.

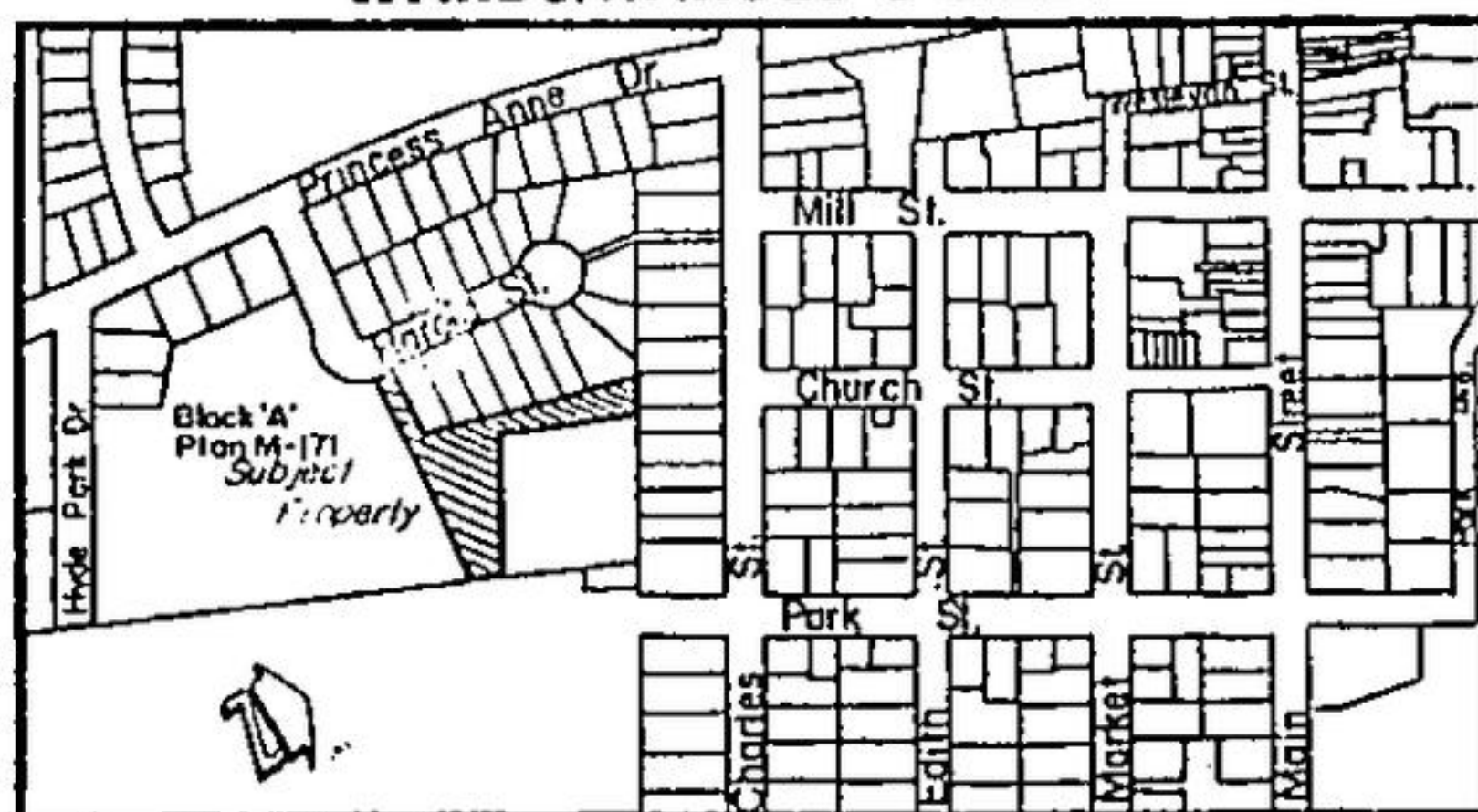
