To become counsellors for the camp, each had to attend physiotherapy sessions along with standard first aid classes. Both Ms. Wright and Ms. Stephens are first year counsellors with the program while Ms. Wallace is in his second

year. Mr. Wallace says that parents of children who attended last year's camp had nothing but praise for the counsellors.

Registration for this year's camp will be at Holy Cross School in Georgetown. The cost is \$59 per week per child. For more information, contact The Lung Association at (416) 632-8499.

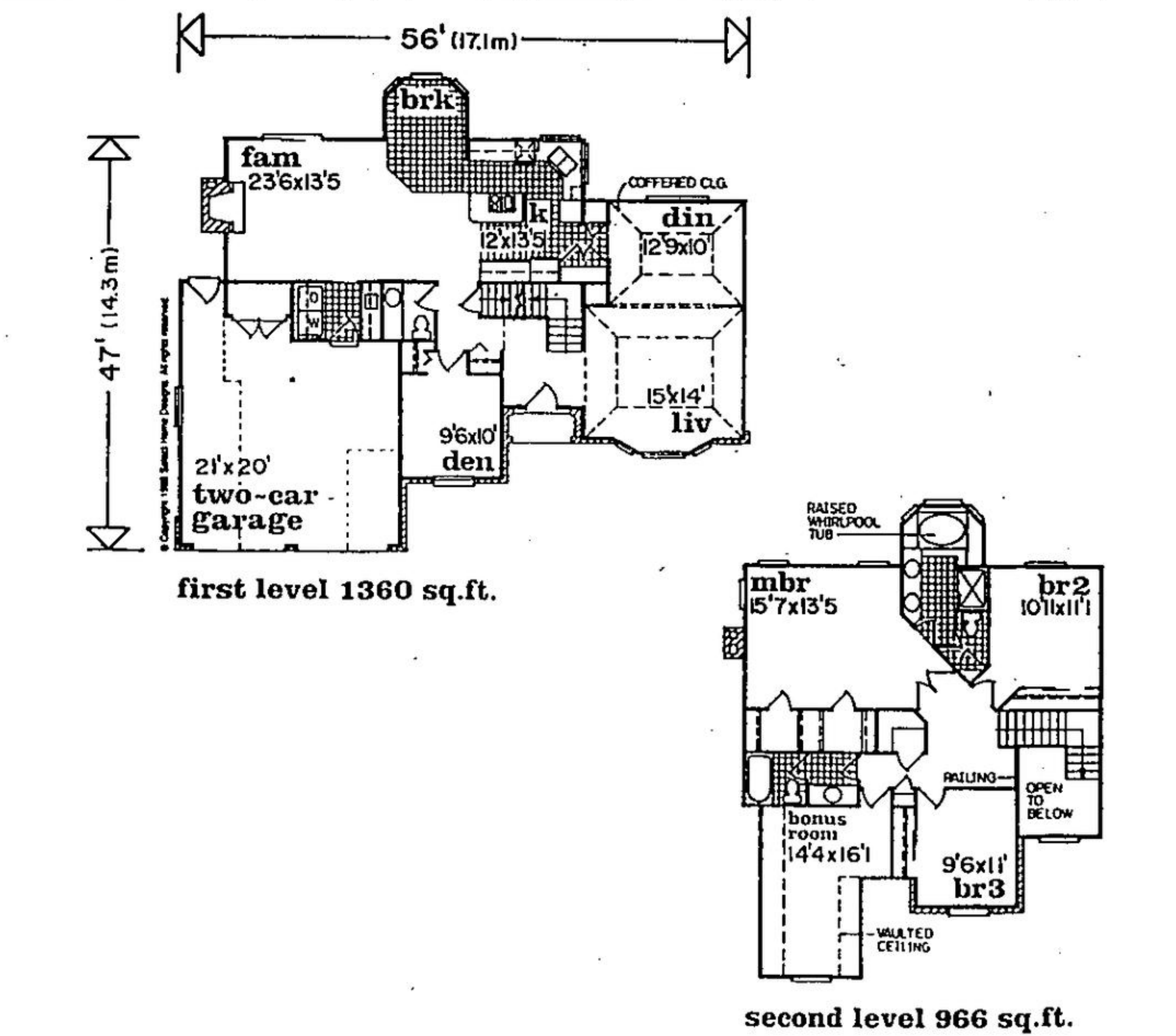
