Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital is budgeted to break even next year, the hospital's treasurer, Barry Kedwell, told directors and citizens at the hospital's annual general meeting Thursday night.

his report, Mr. Kedwell stated that a surplus from 1991 of \$5,125,112 will aid hospital management in presenting a balanced budget for 1992.

Currently, the hospital has \$4,897,203 in assets, \$7,664,363 in fixed assets and is expecting \$225,639 from the Georgetown and District Memorial Hospita. Foundation.

Hospital revenue as of March 31, 1991, is \$13,139,380 with an expenditure of \$12,286,601 leaving a surplus of revenue over expenditure as recognized by the Ministry of Health of \$852,779.


In other business, hospital members passed a motion to change the ex-officio member fee from \$10 to \$25 and the life member fee from \$100 to \$250.
