






Consumer Warning

Beware of infant seat

The Hamilton Automobile Club in cooperation with Transport Canada, is advising consumers of a potential problem with the Fisher-Price Model 9149 infant seat. In certain types of severe crashes the buckle on the crotch strap may separate from the metal tongue, allowing the infant in the seat to be unrestrained by the harness system. This may cause a problem in secondary impacts when the vehicle is thrown into other vehicles or obstructions.

This problem affects 4,000 units distributed in Canada and a number of seats in the United States. The product affected is a blue canopied car seat which is designed for use in the rearfacing position for very young infants. Only those seats manuafactured between January 1, 1991 and February 27, 1991 are affected. The regular Fisher-Price Car Seat Model 9102 is not affected by this modification program.

manufacture falls within this

period. The date is located on the side of the seat.

Anyone in possession of one of these models should contact Fisher-Price to obtain a free replacement shield and appropriate installation instructions. Consumers may call 1-800-233-4004 or write to Fisher-Price Canada at 5300 Tomken Road, Mississauga, Ontario, LAW 1P2. If an alternate seat is not available, consumers may .continue to use the restraint until they receive a replacement shield.

To date, Fisher-Price and Transport Canada have not received any complaints concerning the problem. The concern is raised as a result of tests on this Fishermodel conducted by Price.

The Hamilton Automobile Club affiliated with the 3.3 · million member CAA is convinced that properly used vehicle seat belts and child restraints reduce fatalities and serious injury. The Association operates a National Child Restraint Information Program in concert with Transport Canada to provide current information to consumers and special interest groups on occupant restraint issues.
