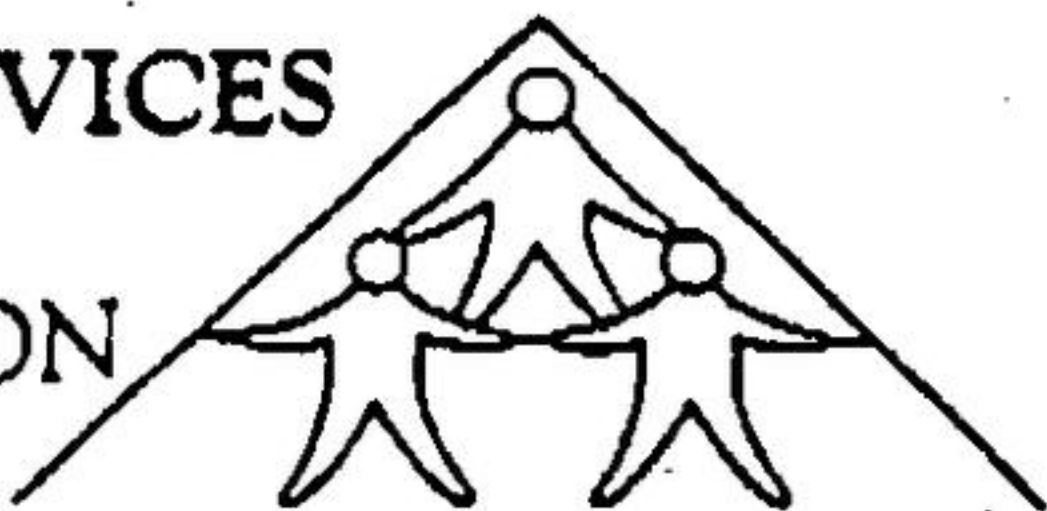
Donna will be competing at the I.P.M. in Lambton County at Petrolia, September 17-21.

PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE DESIGN PLANS MAPLE AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION CNR TO RIVER DRIVE GEORGETOWN

The Town of Halton Hills invites you to attend a Public Information Centre to view the design plans for the reconstruction of Maple Avenue in Georgetown. The project extends from the Canadian National Railway Line to River Drive.

This Public Information Centre is the second of two for the project. It will be an informal meeting where plans showing construction details of the preferred scheme will be available for viewing by area residents and other interested parties. The preferred scheme has been selected by using defined evaluation criteria and public comments. Town of Halton Hills staff and representatives from the Consulting Engineers for this project, DS-Lea Associates Ltd., will be available to discuss the project.
