Wildlife enhancement program wins national recognition

The Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters (OFAH), are proving that wildlife and agriculture can benefit the other through its Wildlife Enhancement Program. Now in its third year, the project recently won the Doug Clarke Memorial Award from the Canadian Wildlife Federation (CWF).

The Doug Clarke Memorial Award is presented annually to a CWF member organization for the most outstanding conservation project by the organization, its clubs or its members.

In conjunction with Wildlife Habitat Canada, the O.F.A.H. are working with private landowners and conservation groups to facilitate the land stewardship practices introduced by the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food.

More landowners than ever are

becoming interested in conservation farming, especially in Southern Ontario where agricultural activities can greatly influence wildlife and its habitat.

Advancements in agriculture have placed many species of wildlife in jeopardy. Although some species such as the northern bobwhite quail, ring-necked pheasant, and the grey partridge have adapted themselves to agricultural land, they still require some sort of diversified cover - something that future farms in southern Ontario may be unable to offer.

For this reason, the O.F.A.H. will continue to work cooperatively with the agricultural community to maintain and develop wildlife habitat on private lands through the wildlife. Habitat Enhancement Program.

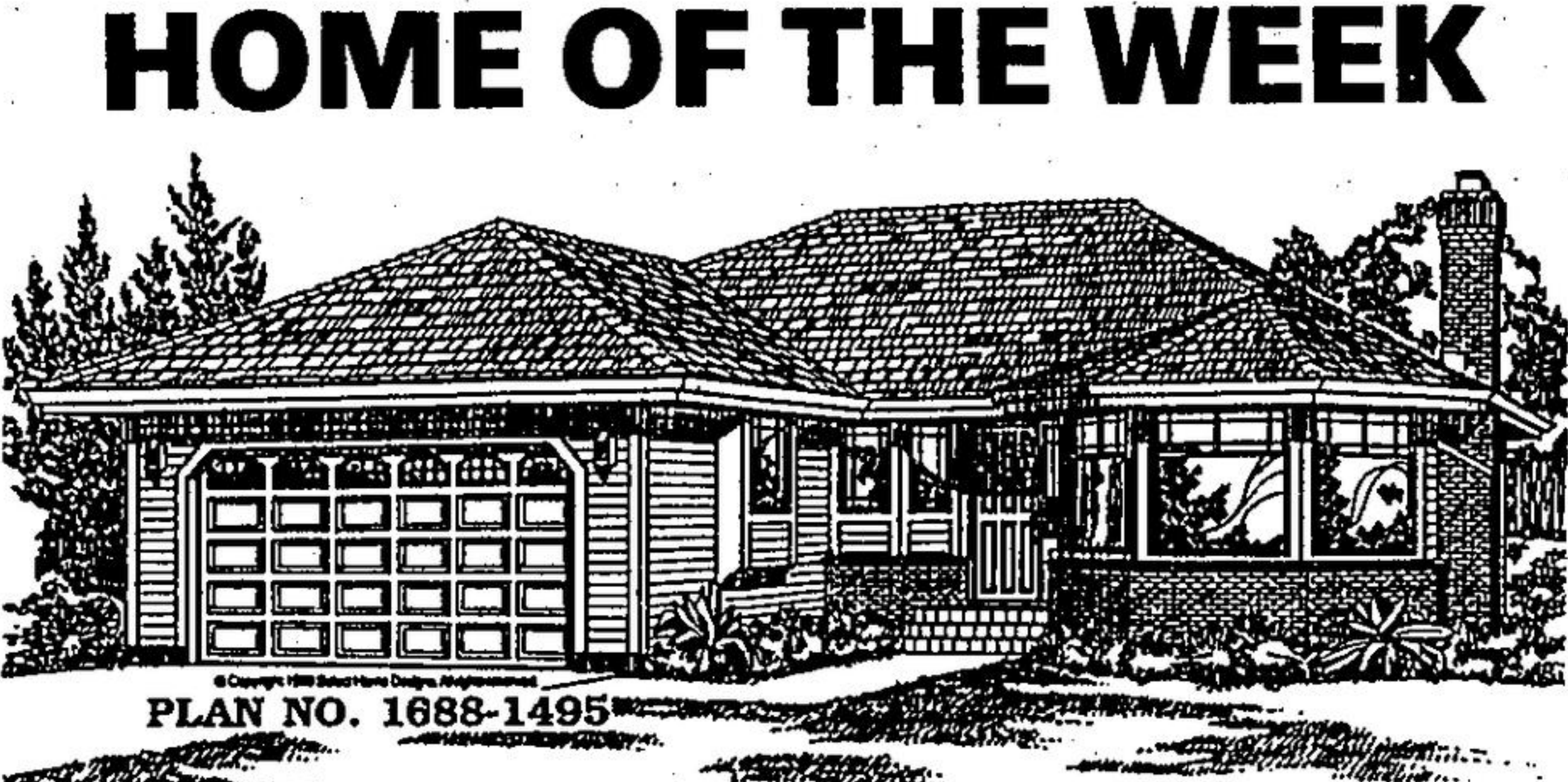
