

## Downtown area gets fruit and vegetable market

Georgetown shoppers now have a place to purchase fresh fruits and vegetables while cruising down Main Street. G.T. Paradise, located at 30 Main Street next to the Bank of Commerce, is a family run grocery store offering fresh produce and grocery foods.

Store manager Adnan Alfnous has lived in Georgetown for the past two years and began seeking space to open his grocery store early in June. The store opened its doors last Monday, July 15.

Mr. Alfnous moved to Georgetown from Toronto in 1989 where he worked as a sales manager with an electronics company. He explained that at the time he was more interested in becoming self-employed. He came to Canada in early 1989 with his family from England.

He explained that Georgetown

is a suitable location for a business such as his. He had initially tried to locate on Guelph Street but was unsuccessful due to a lack of business space. However, he finds his present location acceptable. He stated that business was slow but steady during the first week of operations and that he plans to add in a small bakery and deli area when, and if things pick up.

"I know that the recession is hurting business now but I have a good feeling that business will improve in the future," Mr. Alfnous said.

G.T. Paradise is open seven days a week, from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday to Saturday and 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Sunday. The store will be having a grand opening later on in the summer.

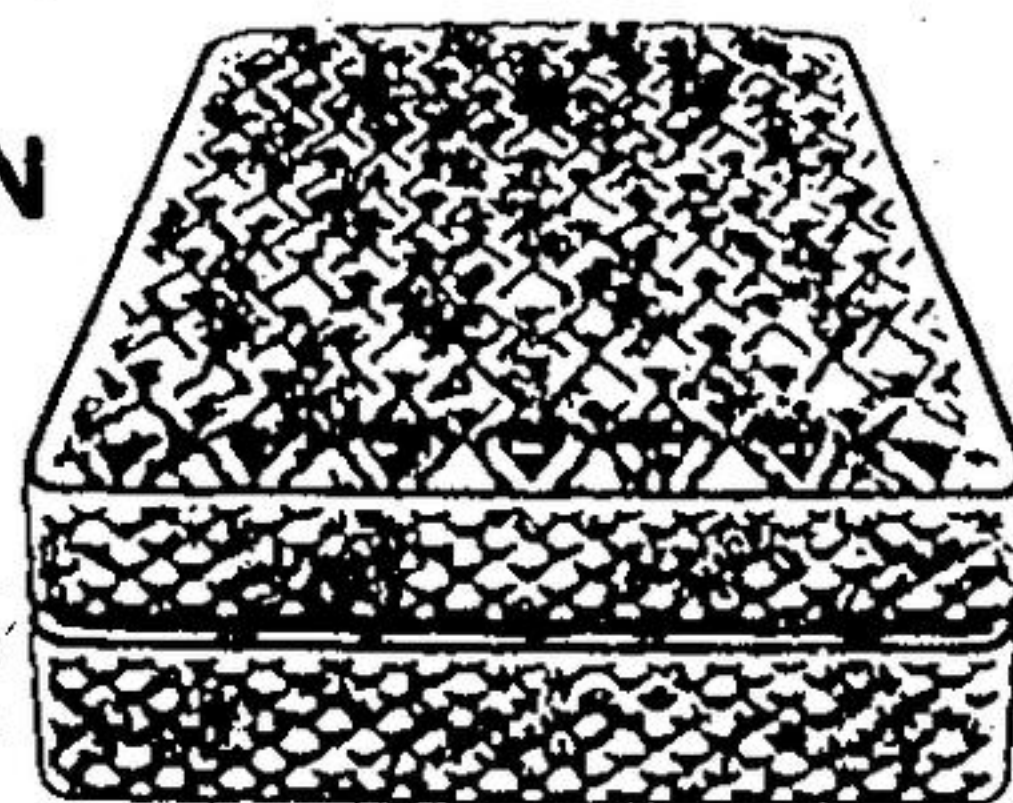

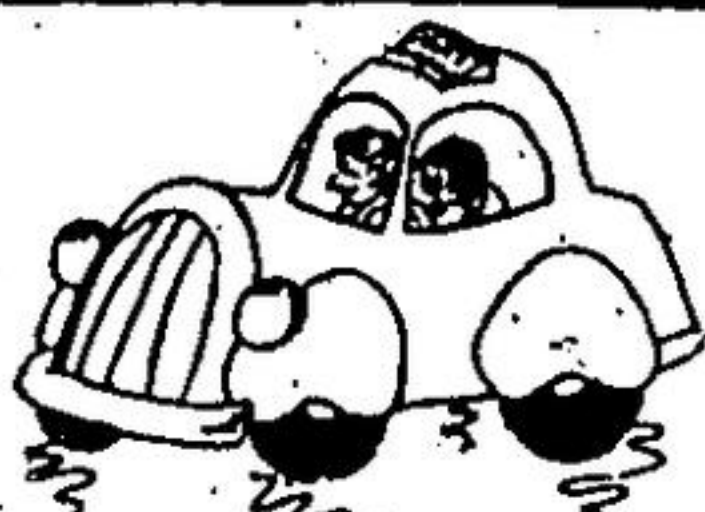
