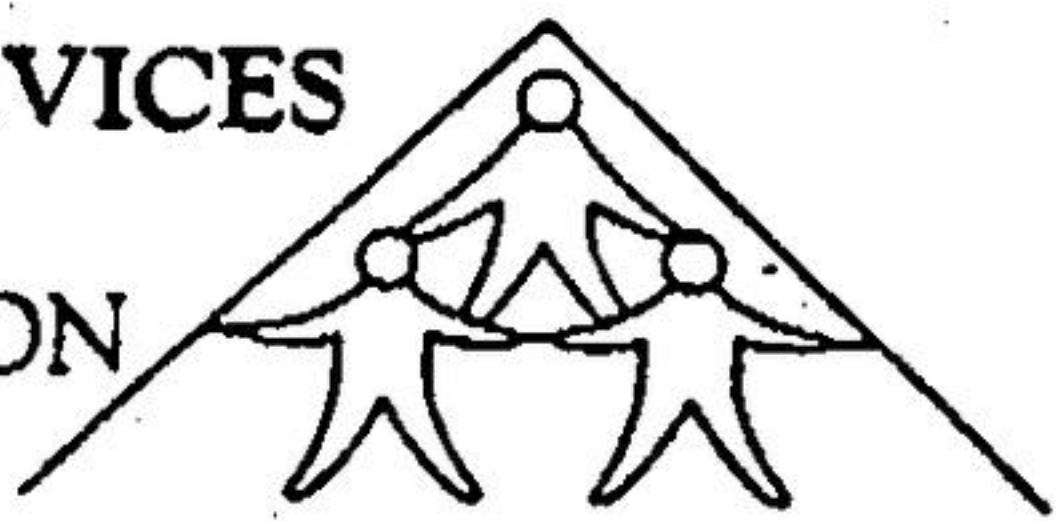

Advice on documents readily available

Questions about Application Forms?

If you want to start working, you will need a Social Insurance Number. If you have quit work, you may wish to apply for Canada Pension. If you are approaching 65 years of age, you may wish to apply for Old Age Security as well. If you have lost your wallet, you may need to apply for a Birth Certificate, Social Insurance Card and Health Card. The where's and when's of these forms can be confusing. Hopefully the information below will help you to know where to get the forms, what documents to send with the forms and where to go if the photocopy of the document must be verified.

Birth Certificate: You can obtain documents from ASSIC or Employment Office. No accompanying documents are necessary. Cost \$10.00.

Social Insurance Number: You can obtain documents from ASSIC or Employment Office. Accompanying documents necessary are birth certificate or passport plus one other piece of I.D. such as library or student card, or baptismal papers. Documents can be verified at Manpower. Cost: First time - no cost. Renewal will cost \$10.00.

Severance approved

The Ontario Municipal Board, (OMB) has supported the proposed severance of a piece of property located at Charles Street and Park Avenue in Georgetown, despite opposition to the severance by neighboring residents.

In supporting the severance the OMB overturned an earlier decision by Halton Region Land Division Committee opposing the severance application.

Located on the property is an historic two-storey house and an A-frame house. The severance calls for the property to be severed to create two different properties. The result calls for the historic property to be located on a piece of property approximately 115 feet by 90 feet.

According to the OMB decision, several residents opposed the application because the severed property would be too small for the size of the historic house. "The residents felt this large historic house would look more appropriate on a large lot," according to the OMB decision.

The decision's author Donald Middleton writes, "in addition to the concerns for the character of the area, a number of the residents expressed a concern that the reduction in lot size for this big house might have the effect of reducing the value of the property if it was put on a smaller lot, and that the reduction of value would reflect itself on other adjacent properties."

Finally, Mr. Middleton wrote, "there was also a concern that granting the severance could set a precedent allowing for the intensification which might also change the character of the area."

Despite the concerns, Mr. Middleton agreed with the assessment of the proposal by Town planner Glen Wellings who calls the severance minor in nature and therefore allowable.

According to the decision, Mr. Wellings provided evidence indicating the severance application was "minor and appropriate for development and use of the land."

Old Age Security, Canada Pension, Disability, Survivors, Guaranteed Income Supplement: You can obtain documents from OAS and Canada Pension at ASSIC Office. Others from Income Security Office (519) 800-265-9480, (416) 1-800-263-8391. Accompanying documents necessary are birth certificate or citizenship papers. In some cases a marriage certificate. Documents can be verified at ASSIC Office or Manpower Office. There is no cost.

Health Card: You can obtain documents from ASSIC Office or Ministry of Health. 268-1154. Accompanying document necessary is a photocopy of birth certificate. No verification necessary and there is no cost.
