### Questions and answers

Question: I have brown spots on the edges of the leaves of my Crimson King Maple, what is happening to the tree?

Answer: This is a common question with a working answer. When you inspect your trees and discover a leaf disorder of any kind, take a long look at how the leaf has been affected. Ask yourself are the leaves being eaten? The damage is usually uniform in habit, if the markings

disease problem! Does the edge of the leaf appear to be uniformly brown all around the edge of the leaf. This particular problem is usually related to the root system unless you experienced a phenomenal shift in temperature in spring. When weather prematurely heats up in spring and all plants begin activity the growth is tender and young. This growth is very susceptible to damage. If the weather turns cold and freezes this tender growth will be burned because those tender shoots contain a lot of water. Therefore the rupture of the cell wall will leave dead tissue which in turn provides a receiving area for disease and pest problems. It is important to recognize how a plant is being impaired by nature. Once you determine the problem and at what stage the problem is at then and only then do you take measures to solve the problem. If you cannot determine the origin of the problem clip off a sample inside crossing branch where healthier parts meet the problem, place it tification. Question: My lawn has dry pat-

ches even though I water regularly when its hot, what is wrong?

Answer: The problem is probably your watering time and quantity of water you're giving your lawn. When watering your lawn you leave your sprinkler position for approximately 3 hours for a 6" depth of water penetration, which is what you need to water the roots or encourage them down there where they should be. The roots then flourish in cooler temperatures with more nutrient availability. If you change the sprinkler too often all you do is syringe the grass and allow 1-2" of watering depth. The roots will now turn up to the water resulting in loss of roots at the preferred depth and shallow roots which heat sress due to poor conditions from drying during the heat of day. Try to water in the mornings before the heat of the day due to the plants growth cycle and then there is much less evaporation. If the sod or seed is being established on a slope you must watch your timing of watering due to the angle of the slope. Twenty minutes per sprinkler position until you cut the first time return to the proper time.
