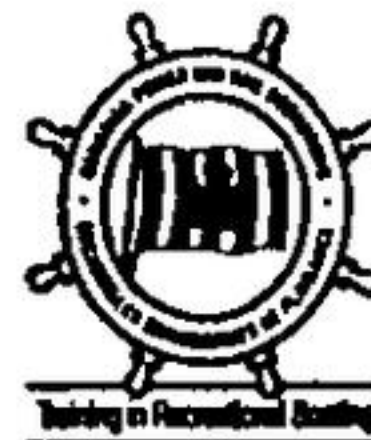
Canadian Power and Sail Squadrons Course

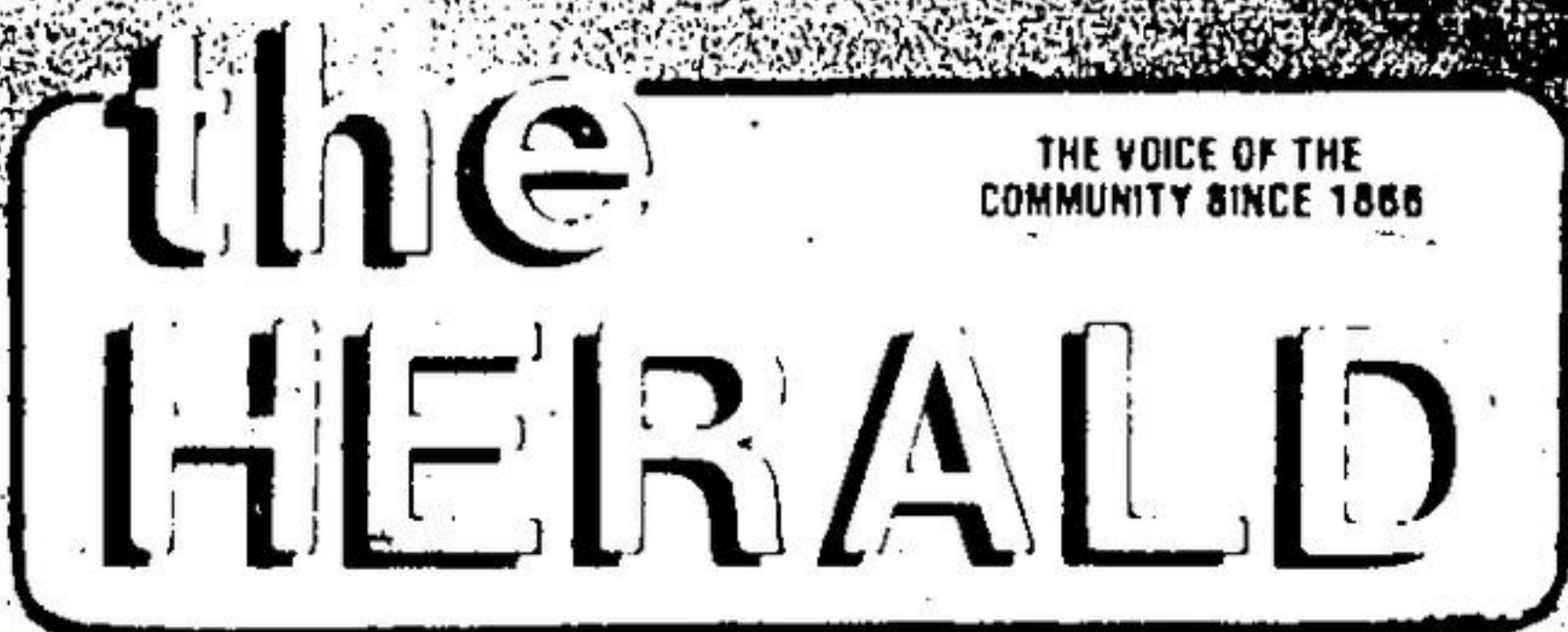
