### An organization with a mission

The United Way of Halton Hills is an organization with a mission: "To increase the organized capacity of the community to care for one another." And while this goal seems achievable enough, the United Way can't stagnate. It must constantly adapt to the changing needs of Halton Hills and its residents.

There are presently 19 partner/member agencies receiving funding from the United Way of Halton Hills - a number that's not etched in stone. In fact, the United Way strives hard to stretch its resources just a little further... to add more member agencies... to serve more Halton Hills citizens.

For example, increased finan-

cial contributions to the United Way would enable the organization to help fund the Halton Adolescent Support Services (HASS), an agency that works with alienated young boys and girls aged 13 to 18 years. Available through HASS are support services such as alternative living arrangements, community-based outreach services, and educational programs for youngsters who, for a variety of reasons, are unable to function in the regular school environment as a result of home or social difficulties.

Then there's the Georgetown Parent-Child Centre, first established in 1988 to address the needs of parents and caregivers of preschoolers.

The list of programs available

through the Parent-Child Centre is extensive. From helping foster support networks among families, or providing educational seminars, to acting as an outlet for social interaction of both adults and children, the Centre addresses the needs of parents whose energies and time are devoted to the challenging job of parenting.

For the illiterate, a door opened to the world of the printed word when the North Halton Literacy Guild was established five years ago.

Since that time, the Guild has been providing adults with one-on-one tutoring by a dedicated group of trained volunteers. These volunteers regularly work with their adult learner students to develop or upgrade their reading, writing, spelling and math skills.

These organizations are only a few of the many that have approached the United Way of Halton Hills for funding. If the United Way is to continue to meet its mission, it needs your support.
