**Scouts Canada chief to visit**

Jim Blain, Chief Executive of Scouts Canada, will visit the Central Escarpment Region this Monday and Tuesday. It will be his first visit since the amalgamation of scouting's Halton Region and Credit Valley Region in September 1990.

His itinerary will include a visit to the training centre at Blue Springs Scout Reserve near Acton, and television interviews at Halton Cable Systems in Acton, Cablenet in Burlington and Rogers in Brampton.

A tour of the seven districts (North Halton, Oakville, Milton, Burlington, Brampton, Malton and Yellow Briar) will ensure that his two days are packed with activities.

Mr. Blain's journeys across Canada from his Ottawa base enable him to keep in touch with Scouting at the grass roots level. He can discuss the concerns and successes with those who make scouting work on a day-to-day basis, confirming that youth programmes stay topical in changing times. Of particular current interest are the change to a new uniform, and admitting girls to junior sections in some areas.

A major interest for Blain is the training of adults in manage-

ment, communications and personal relationships as well as the more traditional skills.

All adult scouting members will have opportunity to meet the Chief Executive at a dinner to be held in his honour Monday night in Milton.

Scouting in Central Escarpment Region has more than 7,000 youth members, with contribution by almost 2,000 adult volunteers.

For the comfort of prospective buyers, the auction will be held indoors (in the heated garage), and refreshments will be available for sale by the Police Chorus.

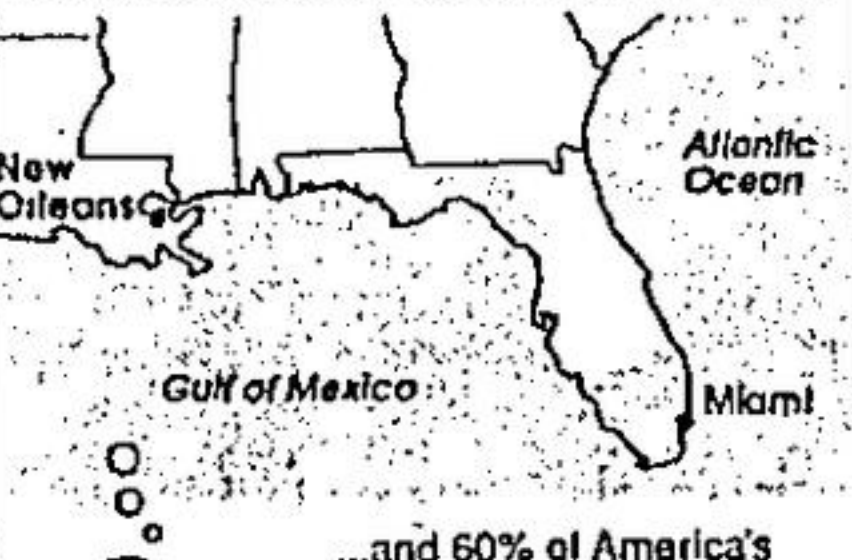
