Halton Hills Firefighters got their exercise walking the Georgetown Santa Claus parade route and handing out suckers to youngsters. (Herald photo)



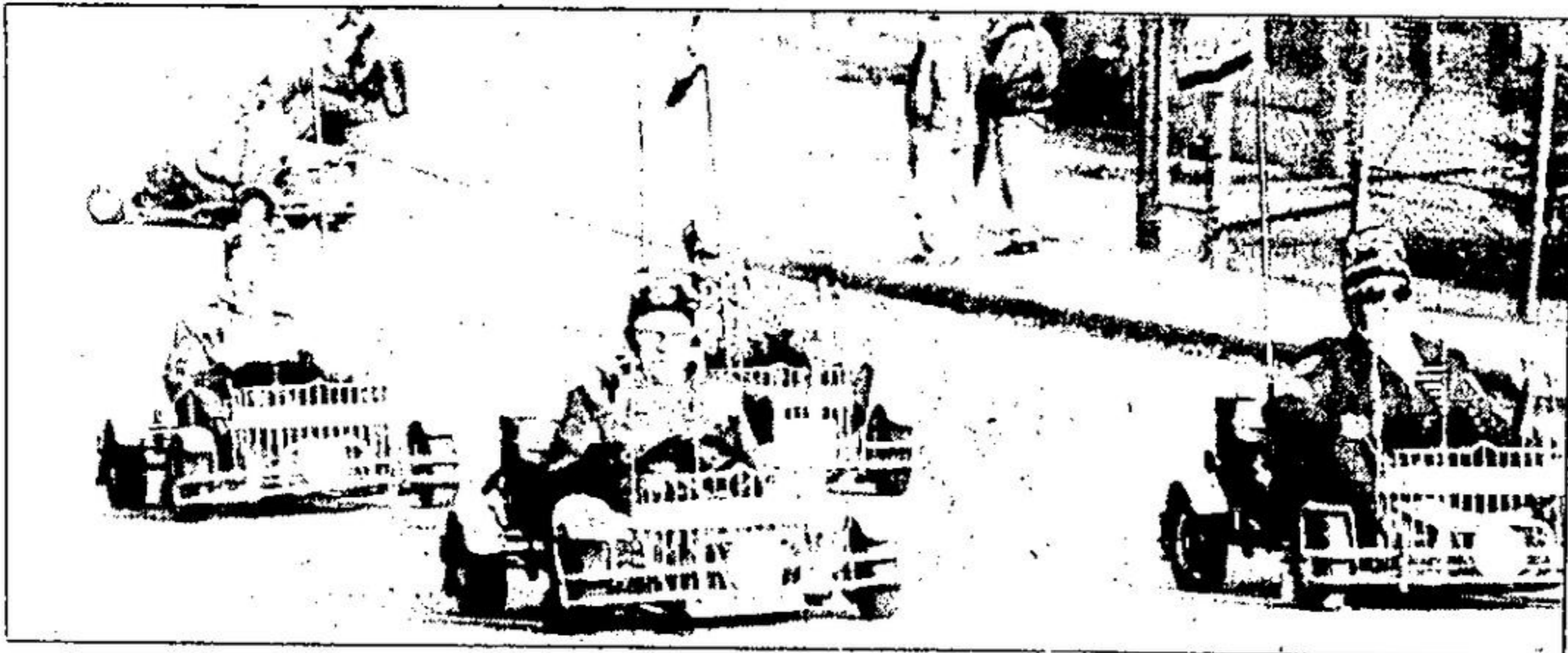

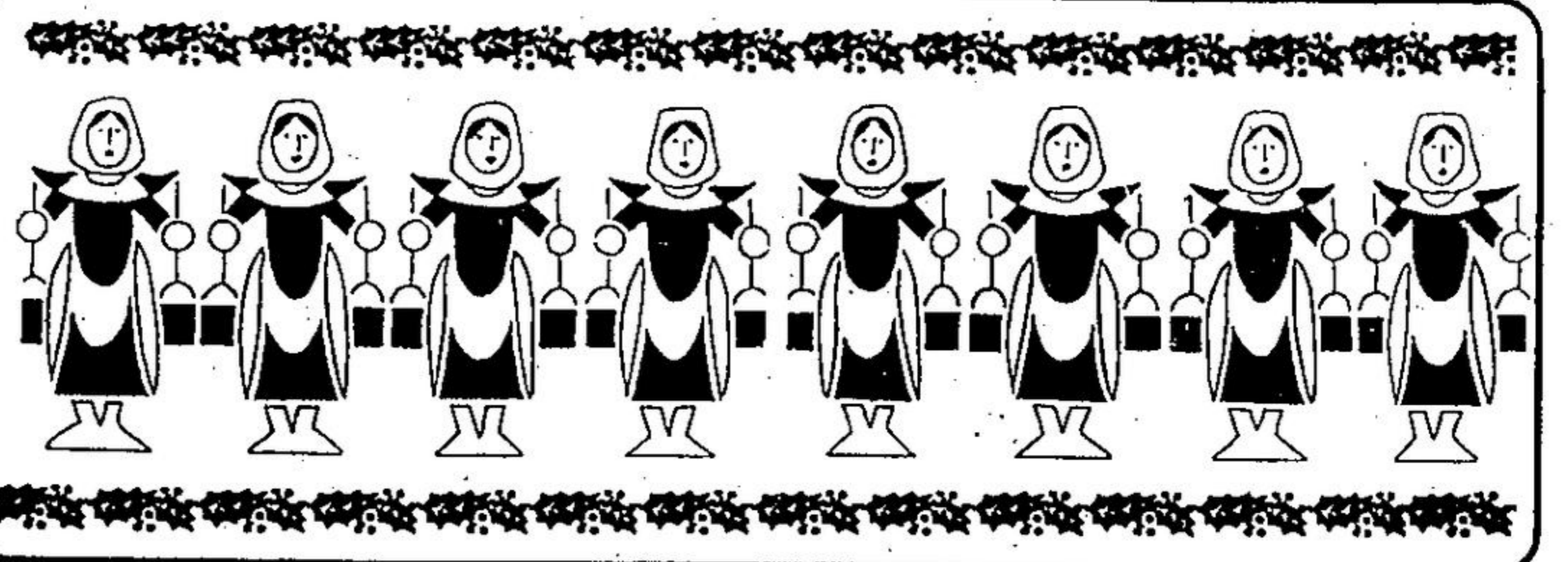
