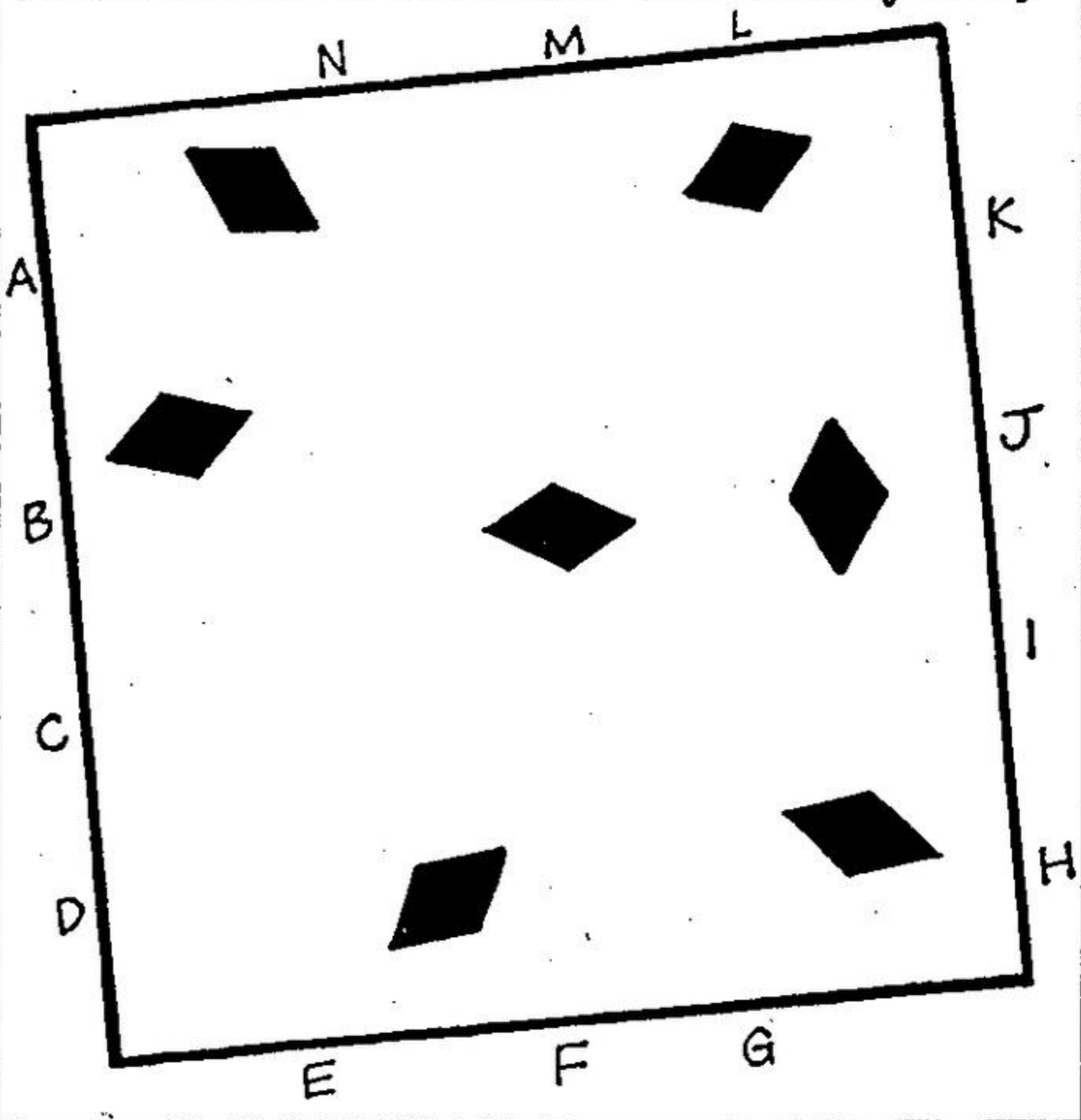
Canadian Trivia
