You know it's been a hot summers' day when you pull into your driveway to find the asphalt on your street is wrapped around your tires.


Canadians have come together this summer for festivals, fairs - and to fight over parking spots near the main entrance gates.

You know summer is half over when you look out your front window and notice the lawn is half dead.


STRANGE SCISSORS
