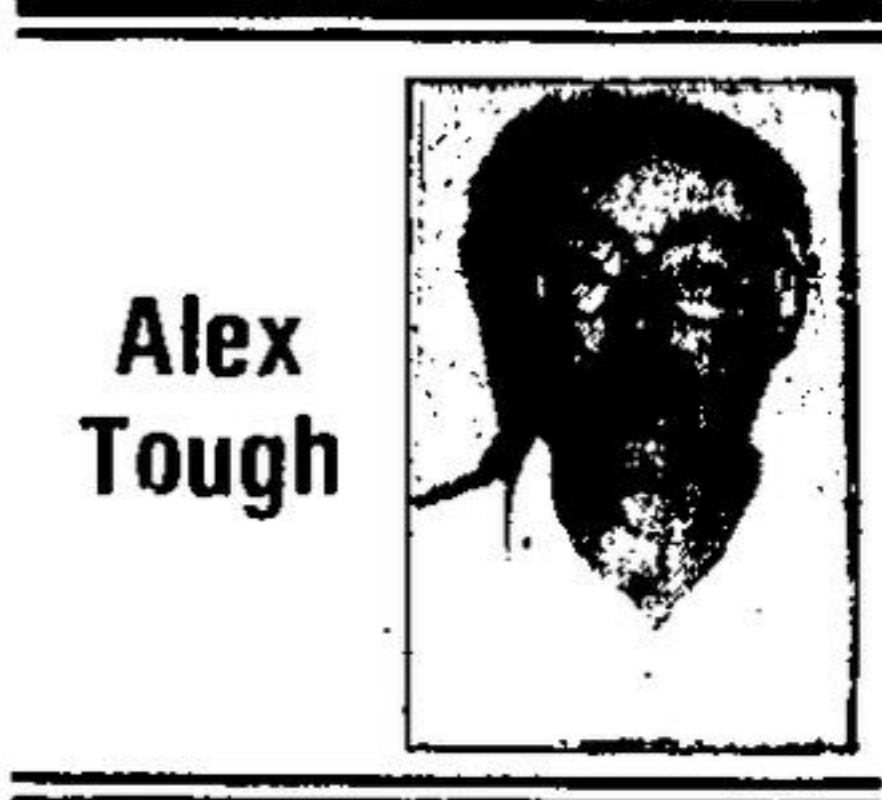
# George No. 1 leads pack in Halton Dart League action
