Party Cinemas began three years ago when Andrews, a DJ, and Marsh held an outdoor movie/barbecue for their friends, and were surprised when a lot of passing cars stopped to see what was going on.

The business grew to include monthly video dances, popular movies in the park during the summer, and special events and parties. "I think we caught on because we are community-minded and we want to give back to the community with charitable events," Andrews said.
