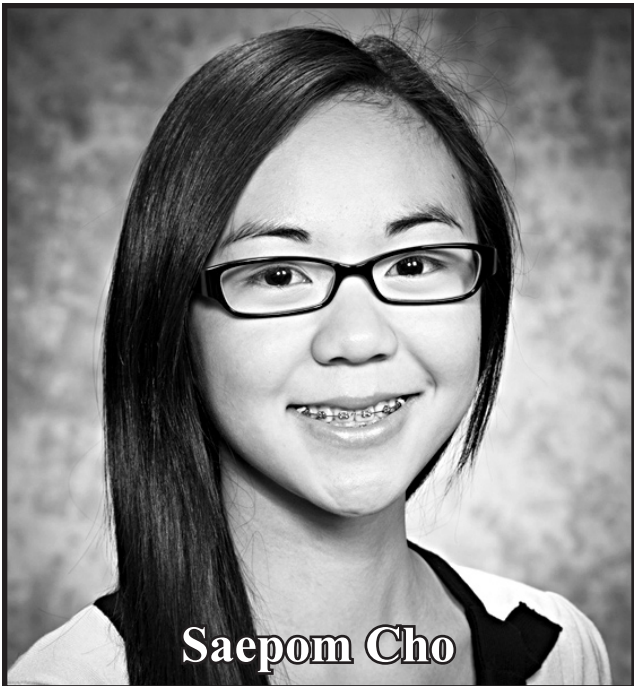
**Victoria McCutcheon

Victoria is a kind, quiet student who always has a smile to share. She can be relied on to put forward her

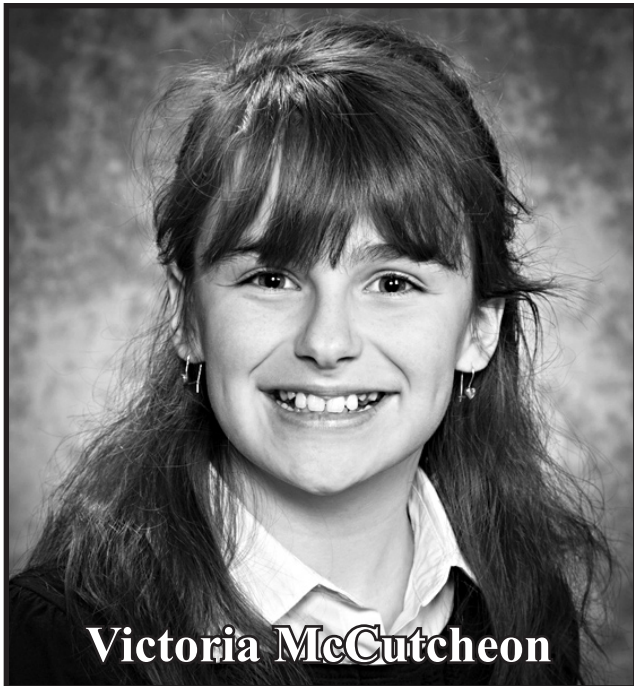

Grade 12**

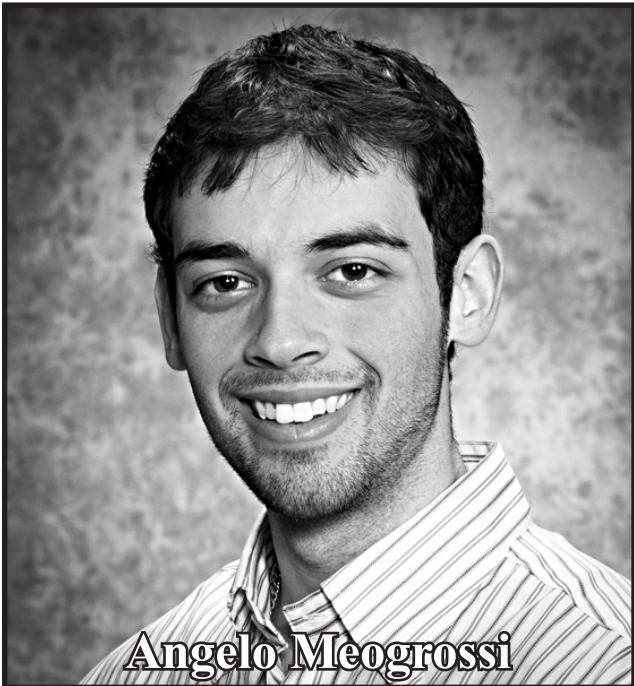

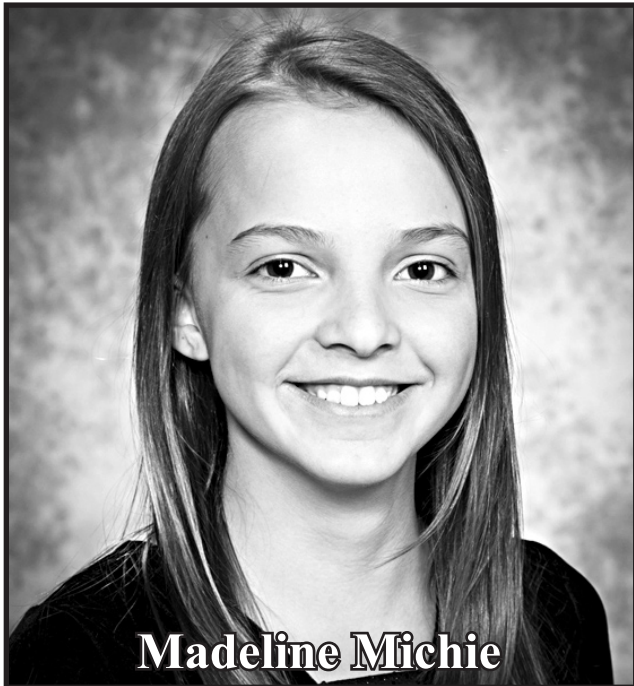
