Cash for summer cycling events

The Town has earmarked up to \$7,500 to support the Canadian Road Cycling Championships and Festival. Halton Hills was chosen by Midweek

Cycling Club to host two cycling events this summer, one in Limehouse and one in Georgetown where the plans call for a BMX demonstration, a

safety clinic, a youth skills competition, local vendors and buskers. Plans to the Limehouse event are still being formulated.

The Town will recruit and train over 50 volunteers to help with the Georgetown event and 20 for the Limehouse one, similar to its efforts for the Olympic Torch Relay. The \$7,500 will help pay for course signage, promotional materials, event equipment and advertising.
