

## Hospital labs get high status

Halton Healthcare Services (HHS) went "under the microscope" for an entire week in April of 2009 during the accreditation of its Laboratory Services at Georgetown Hospital, Milton District Hospital and Oakville-Trafalgar Memorial Hospital by the Quality Management Program-Laboratory Services (QMP-LS) provincial regulatory agency.

All three HHS hospital laboratories demonstrated outstanding performance during this stringent Ontario Laboratory Accreditation (OLA) and were each recently granted the highest possible status—a full 4-year accreditation certificate as of Sept. 21, 2009.

"We were delighted with our results. It is truly reflective of our program and we are extremely proud of this accomplishment. It provides our patients, families and the community at large with assurances that we are meeting national standards of quality in our laboratories," said Rosemary Prikosovich, HHS Director of Diagnostic Imaging and Laboratory Services.

"Accreditation is a mandatory, comprehensive review which helps ensure standardization of laboratory services across the province—that the quality of a laboratory result in Toronto is the same as that achieved by a laboratory in Halton Hills or Milton or at the bedside," said Prikosovich.

HHS' three hospital laboratories demonstrated very high conformance rates of 96.75 per cent, 98.58 per cent and 97.37 per cent at Georgetown, Milton District, and Oakville Trafalgar, respectively.
