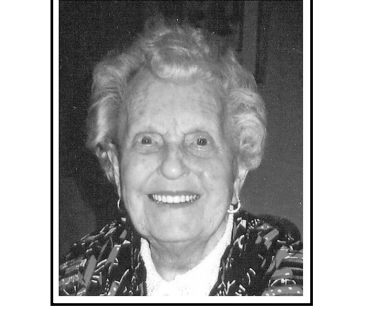
CLARKE, Flora Grace
