

Additional dates slated for Hydro One hearing

Several additional dates have been added for a hearing in which some area residents are appealing a Niagara Escarpment Commission decision to conditionally approve a development permit application by Hydro One Networks Inc. to build a hydro transmission line through part of Halton Hills.

The hearing, which has already been heard over several days, will continue Feb. 19, 22-25, March 22-26, April 6, 8, and 9.

The hearing will be held in the Civic Centre council chambers.

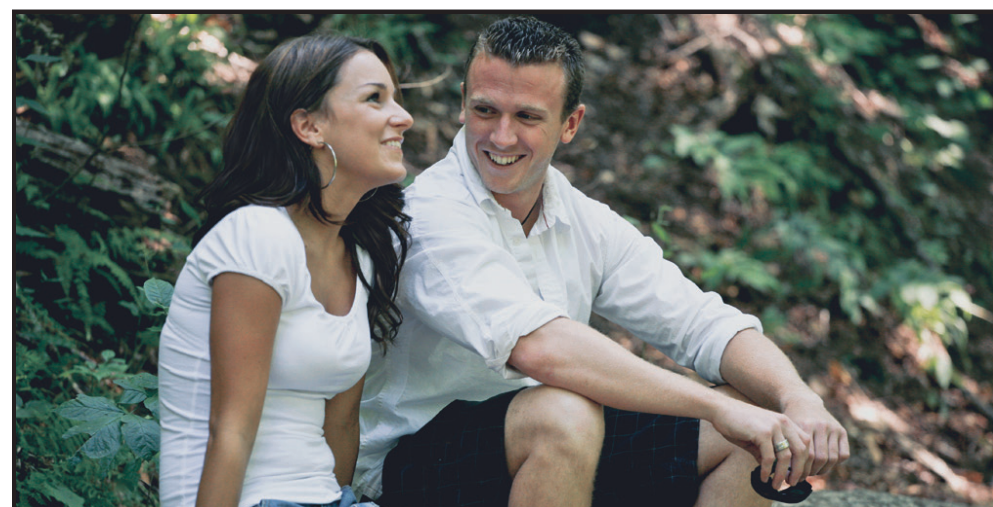
