Acton High School Student Council is hosting a benefit concert for the victims of the earthquake in Haiti on Saturday, Feb. 20, at the Roxy on Mill St. E. in Acton.

There is no set donation fee, however, entrance is a minimum donation of \$5. There will be door prizes, as well as many different auction items for bid in the silent auction.
