lucky indeed to have such dedicated ladies.

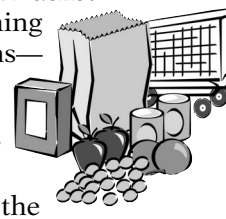
Our next general Ladies Auxiliary meeting will be on Thursday, March 18 at 8 p.m.
