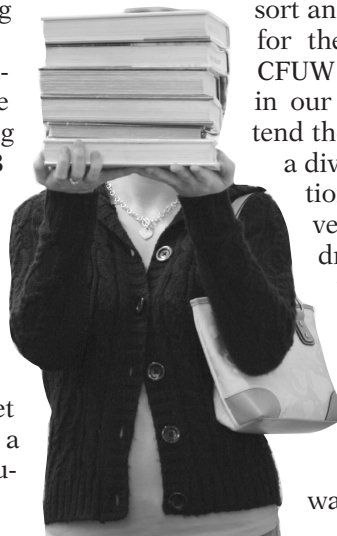
Every year it has used the proceeds from the sale to distribute scholarships to excelling Halton Hills graduates who are pursuing post secondary education.
