In Halton Hills

Hydro drop for Earth Hour half the total it was last year

Hydro consumption in Halton Hills was down about seven per cent during Earth Hour Saturday evening.

The results were poorer than the previous year when the town saw a 13.5 per cent energy consumption reduction during the event designed to raise awareness of the need to decrease energy use and take action against climate change.

Hydro consumption during Earth Hour—8:30 to 9:30 p.m.—is compared to the hour before it.

The drop in consumption was not as great this year right across the province.

On Saturday, Ontario saw a four per cent drop in electricity demand during Earth Hour, which was less than the six per cent drop in 2009 and five per cent in 2008.

This year's drop in consumption across Ontario saw a reduction of 560 megawatts, which was enough to power the City of Brampton.
