You are invited to attend a Public Information Meeting to be held by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Caledon to consider the proposed Town-initiated Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments pertaining to Drive-through facilities. Your attendance and comments at this meeting are welcome as it is your opportunity to learn more about the proposed policy direction and express any opinions that you may have. The meeting is scheduled for:

PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

The draft Official Plan Amendment (OPA 204) proposes to introduce policies in the Town of Caledon Official Plan related to Drive-through facilities. The associated amendment to the Comprehensive Zoning By-law, 2006-50 as amended, proposes to implement the proposed policy provisions of the Official Plan including the establishment of a 90 metre setback requirement for new Drive-through facilities from a residential zone or a lot containing a residential use.

The purpose of these amendments is to provide clearer policy direction as well as establish regulations that will facilitate the development of Drive-through facilities in the Town while at the same time, fostering the health and well-being of Caledon residents and minimizing potential impacts on existing and proposed sensitive land uses.

At the meeting members of the public will have the opportunity to learn about the proposed amendments to the Official Plan and Zoning By-law and ask questions of staff. Please note that Council will not be making a decision to adopt these draft amendments at the May 19, 2010 Public Information Meeting. The purpose of this meeting is solely to receive public comments.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

An information package consisting of draft OPA 204, proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, the Design Guidelines for drive-through facilities, and associated material related to the study will be available to the public for review 20 days prior to the meeting at the Planning Department, Town of Caledon, 6311 Old Church Road, Caledon East, Ontario. Office hours are Monday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Written submissions may be mailed or personally delivered to the Planning and Development Department at the above noted address. NOTIFICATION

If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments you must make a written request to the Town of Caledon, Planning and Development Department, 6311 Old Church Road, Caledon, Ontario L7C 1J6.

APPEAL PROCEDURES POPA 05-02 (pre Bill 51)

If a person or public body that files a notice of appeal of a decision of the Corporation of the Town of Caledon in respect of the proposed Official Plan Amendment does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Corporation of the Town of Caledon before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

APPEAL PROCEDURES RZ 10-04 (Bill 51)

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Corporation of the Town of Caledon before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Corporation of the Town of Caledon to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Corporation of the Town of Caledon before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
