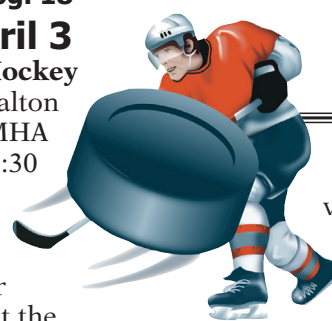
Easter Sunday services:
