This year's rain barrels have a new look and price at only **\$36 each (cash only)**.



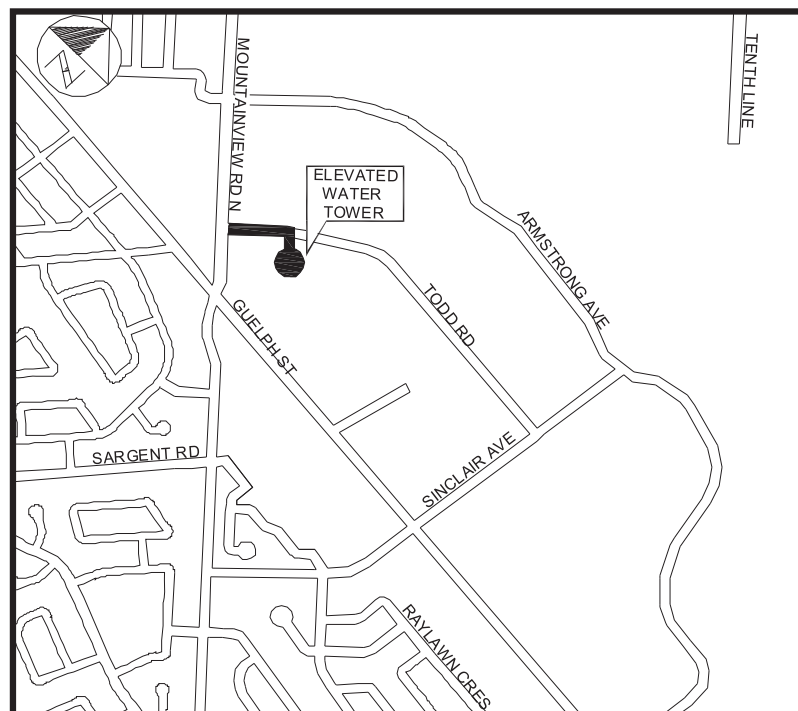

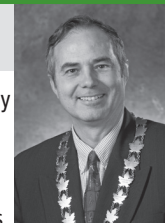
## Meet Halton Regional Chair Gary Carr at YouthFest
