

Tractor worth \$30K stolen

Halton Police report a 2005 International tractor (cab) unit, valued at \$30,000, was stolen sometime between Saturday and Monday morning from a lot on Todd Rd. where several tractor-trailer units were parked.

The white tractor has R & B Freightways Ltd. emblazoned on the side in blue.

Sod at fire hall 'not laid properly'

At least half of the sod that had been laid at the new Halton Hills fire station on 10 Sideroad last fall, has been ripped up and will be replaced, but at no cost to the Town of Halton Hills.

Deputy Chief John Martin said the sod "wasn't laid down properly" and the soil not prepared correctly, so it was identified as a deficiency, and is being replaced under the terms of the contract.

The general contractor for the project will foot the bill for the sod replacement. Martin said not all of the sod around the building will be replaced.

Council recently approved the appointment of Wolfson to become commissioner, one of the top positions at the municipi-
