Be Water Wise: Know Your Colour, Know Your Limits

In the warmer months water consumption often doubles due to outdoor activities such as lawn watering, car washing and watering shrubs and gardens. To ensure a continuous supply of water for essential and emergency services like firefighting, Halton Region has launched a new Outdoor Water Use Strategy designed to quickly and effectively communicate outdoor water use restrictions. The new system is colour coded and establishes three levels of outdoor water use depending on criteria such as water demand, reservoir levels and anticipated weather patterns.
