





WWII sacrifices remembered in Liberation 65 Concert

The Liberation Choir mark the 65th anniversary of the liberation of The Netherlands in the Second World War with a Liberation 65 Concert, on Thursday, May 13, 7:30 p.m. at Georgetown Christian Reformed Church.

The concert is in remembrance of the Allied soldiers, sailors and air force personnel who died during the liberation of the Dutch residents.

The Liberation Choir has 100 members from across the GTA and Southwestern Ontario. They perform throughout the year in support of various community agencies.

A portion of the \$20 ticket price for this concert will go to Cancer Assistance Services of Halton Hills (CAShh).

Enjoy music such as *Battle Hymn of the Republic*, *They all call it Canada*, *Chorus of the Hebrew Slaves* and more. Special guest will be organist Martin Mans of The Netherlands, famous in his home country, and who has toured around the world as an organist and as a conductor of four male choirs.

Also joining the choir for the evening will be The Choraliers, an all-male chorus.
