# Scutt hangs on to top ranking

Local darts ace Chris Scutt has been holding up his ranking as the number-one-rated men's singles player in North America, competing at several tournaments across the continent in 2010.

The 37-year-old roofer was also tops in the National Darts Federation of Canada's rankings released May 1 and recently earned a spot on Team Ontario again this year.

Scutt lost in the finals of a

tournament in Ottawa and tied for fifth at the Vancouver, competing at events in Virginia Beach and North Carolina as well.

He is currently 32nd in the BDO world rankings and his upcoming events include a trip to the Canadian championships in Gander, Nfld. June 15-18 and a return to the Winmau World Masters Championships at the end of October in Hull, England.
