Penny called 911 and her mother was taken to the hospital where she remained through Sunday. She didn't suffer any broken bones.

Davis is home now, and seems fine except for the bruising and pain.

"I don't know if I passed out or tripped on something," said Davis, who was embarrassed by the incident and didn't want to be photographed. Her doctors would like to know what happened as well.

"I would like to know exactly where they found me, what I hit," said Davis.


