Thousands of children in the world are sold into slavery with many ending up in the sex trade. Life for these kids means no holidays, no pay and no future, but six local youngsters are finding One Way to help.

Grade 7 and 8 students Holly Girvan, Torri Huggins, Brittany Webster, Jonah Vetro, Vince Vetro and Sophia Vetro—all members of the Georgetown Alliance Church's Junior Worship Band, make up the band, One Way. In December the group cut a CD called *Freedom*.

The band is holding their CD release party on Friday (May 28) from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. at the Georgetown Alliance Church on 290 Main St. S.
