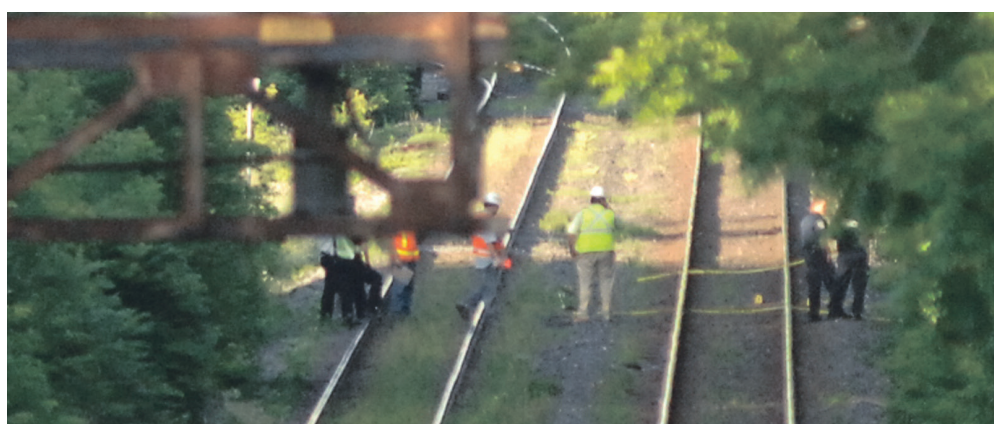

Police believe man hit by train

A man was found dead late Tuesday afternoon beside the railway tracks in the Dayfoot Dr. and Mill St. area of Georgetown.

Halton Regional Police believe the man was struck by a train after conducting an investigation. A citizen reported the discovery to police around 5 p.m.

The male victim is believed to be in his 30s, but his identity had yet to be confirmed as of press time Wednesday.

Trains were stopped in both directions during the time of the investigation, which is continuing.
