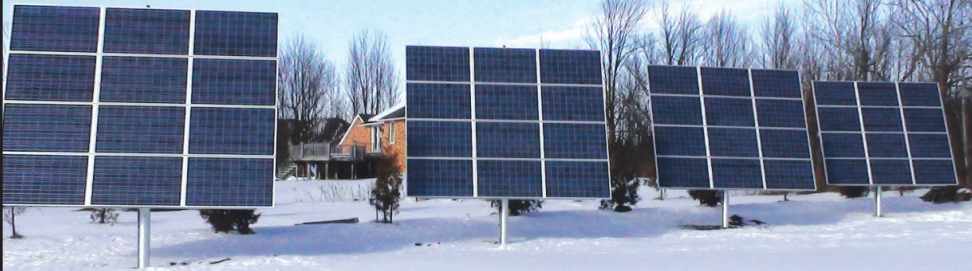

#### 2010 MUNICIPAL ELECTION Candidate Registration Election Day - Monday, October 25, 2010

Anyone wishing to be a candidate in the municipal election to be held on October 25, 2010 for the Town of Caledon may file a nomination form for the offices of:

- Mayor – one to be elected by all electors of the municipality
- Regional Councillor –
  - Ward 1 (one to be elected)
  - Ward 2 (one to be elected)
  - Wards 3 and 4 (one to be elected)
  - Ward 5 (one to be elected)
- Area Councillor -
  - Ward 1 (one to be elected)
  - Ward 2 (one to be elected)
  - Wards 3 and 4 (one to be elected)
  - Ward 5 (one to be elected)
- Trustee, Peel District School Board – one to be elected at large for the Town of Caledon and County of Dufferin
- Trustee, Dufferin-Peel Catholic District School Board – one to be elected at large for the Town of Caledon and County of Dufferin
- Trustee, Conseil Scolaire De District Du Centre-Sud-Ouest – one to be elected at large for the Region of Peel / Un (1) candidat à élire dans toute la région de Peel
- Trustee, Conseil Scolaire De District Catholique Centre-Sud – one to be elected at large for the Town of Caledon, City of Brampton, County of Dufferin and County of Wellington / Un (1) candidat à élire dans tout les villes Caledon et Brampton and comtés de Dufferin et Wellington

Forms may be filed at the Caledon Town Hall, 6311 Old Church Road, Caledon East, Upper Floor, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, until the closing of nominations at 2:00 p.m., Friday, September 10, 2010.

The term of office will be from December 2010 to November 2014.

Nomination papers are available in the Town Clerk's Office at Town Hall or from our web site at [www.caledon.ca](http://www.caledon.ca). Candidates must provide a declaration of qualification (form provided), proof of qualifying address within the Town of Caledon or school board jurisdiction and pay the appropriate nomination filing fee (cash, Interac, certified cheque, or money order made payable to "Treasurer, Town of Caledon"). Nomination fees are as follows:

Mayor	\$200
All other offices	\$100

No person who proposes to be a candidate may solicit or accept contributions for election purposes or incur campaign expenses until he or she has filed a nomination paper.

#### MUNICIPAL ELECTION Compliance Audit Committee

The Town of Caledon is currently seeking interested residents who wish to serve on the Municipal Elections Compliance Audit Committee for the 2010-2014 term of Council.

The Municipal Elections Compliance Audit Committee will review an application for a compliance audit from an elector who believes on reasonable grounds that a candidate has contravened a provision of the *Municipal Elections Act* relating to election campaign finances.

##### Qualifications:

- a) be at least 18 years of age;
- b) a resident of the Town of Caledon;
- c) a Canadian Citizen;
- d) have a financial or legal background and experience;
- e) previous experience on a committee, task force or tribunal would be an asset.

The following individuals will be excluded from membership to the committee:

- a) employees or officers of the Town of Caledon;
- b) members of Town of Caledon council;
- c) any persons who are candidates in the election for which the committee is established or family members or employees of same or any person connected to a candidate through an employment, contractual, business or partnership relationship;
- d) any person who is or intends to volunteer or seek employment to assist any candidate in the election for which the committee is established; or
- e) a current elected member of a municipal council, or of a provincial or federal legislature.

Remuneration: \$100.00 per meeting.

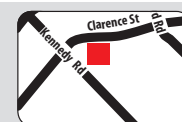
