Municipal Election Compliance Audit Committee

Purpose: This Committee will be responsible for considering and determining whether to grant or reject all applications requesting a compliance audit of a candidate's election campaign finances in accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act (MEA)* and in accordance with the procedures established by the Regional Clerk under the provisions of the MEA.

Members Needed: Three members with qualifications or knowledge in finance/accounting, public administration or law, or knowledge of campaign financing rules under the MEA.

Golf roundup

Great start for Morrow at Mid-Amateur

After sitting in a tie for third after the opening round with a one-over-par 72, Georgetown's Paul Morrow ended up placing 32nd at last week's Golf Association of Ontario Men's Mid-Amateur Championship at the Donalda Club in North York.

The 49-year-old Morrow, a member at the Blue Springs Golf Club in Acton, followed up his 72 with rounds of 81 and 78 to finish at 18 over par, in a tie for 32nd.

Georgetown's Bill Swartz from the Club at North Halton missed the 36-hole cut after rounds of 84 and 80.

Public player Luis Ramirez of Georgetown finished as runner-up in the men's division at last week's GAO One-Day Net Event at the Club at North Halton.

Ramirez carded a net score of one-over-par 73, four shots behind winner Frank Pennetta of Oakville at -3.

Acton teen Andrew Tressell and Derek Smith of Georgetown were tied for third with an 18-hole score of +3.

Eris Laws of Acton's Blue Springs course also placed in a tie for third in the women's division at four over par.
